

Sentences Deferred In Two Robber Cases

Racial Clash Flares At Florida Motel

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. (AP) — A riot broke out at a Florida motel Sunday night, involving a group of about 100 Negroes trying to integrate a motel swimming pool, being met with violence by a troubled city trying to work out its racial problems.

Cries of "Arrest them! Get the dogs!" came from a watching crowd of 100 whites as police raged the pool at the Moulton Motor Lodge and rained blows on heads, backs and shoulders of five Negro men and women.

Finally, the bruised Negroes along with two white companions, climbed out of the jail. There, they joined 55 to 80 other demonstrators, including a group of Jewish clergymen, arrested earlier while trying to be served at a motel restaurant.

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Negro integration leader, said he sent a telegram to U.S. Attorney General Robert Kennedy complaining of "raw brutality" by the police.

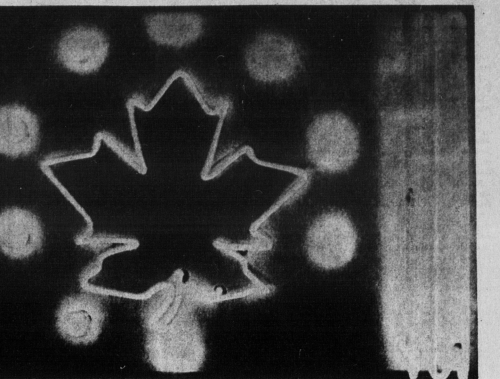

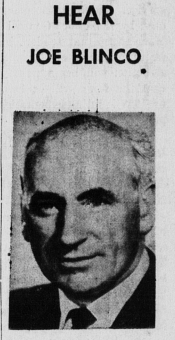
