Both courses offer you a chance to study at a time and place of your choosing.

Because the courses are delivered electronically, students can be located anywhere they have access to the World Wide Web. The university comes to you, wherever you are. If you are registered as a UPEI student, you can get access to the Internet via your Novell account. Or, if you wish to work from home, you can purchase an Internet account through Computer Services (contact Chris Martin at 566-0465).
