PATENT REPORT.—Below will be found the only complete list of patents granted to Canadian inventors by the Canadian Government. This report is prepared especially for this paper by Messrs Marion & Marion, Solicitors of Patents and Experts, New York Building, Montreal; 61-276—Abron H Moore & Horace R Merry, Magog, Q. improvements in railroad spikes; 61,277 John William Hayward, Toronto, Ont, improvements in pie lifters, toasters and broilers; 61,281—Daniel Riopel, l'Assomption, Q. improvements in planing machines; 61,282—Alva Armstrong, Oshawa, Ont, improvements in music boxes attached to bicycles or vehicles; 61,285—James Grant Kerr, Niagara Falls Ont, improvements in Acetylene gas generators.

QUARTZ MINING CLAIMS.—The regulations for the disposition of quartz mining claims on Dominion lands in Manitoba, the Territories and the Yukon have been amended to provide that the Minister of the Interior may grant locations for mining copper in the Yukon each location to consist of an area not exceeding one hundred and sixty acres in a square block, the boundaries lying east, west, north and south, and not more than one block to be granted to the same party within ten miles. The grant contains no rights to any other minerals. The royalty to be paid to the Government on the gross output of copper shall not exceed five per cent, and the Minister of the Interior is empowered to make regulations for ensuring the development of such areas and for the payment of the royalty as he sees fit.
