keeps only a bare bone staff of six inspectors to check every eating establishment in Newfoundland. The shortage of inspectors is so acute that even hospitals are checked only monthly.

Versafood, meanwhile, has promised greater care in the future. Two of its most "efficient experts" while be transferred to Memorial from the mainland, and claims the company, the

move will cut down the possibility of further outbreaks of food-poisoning. Although Versafood claims to be making only "marginal profit" on its Memorial contract, the quality of the food being served at the University dining halls and cafeterias has been deteriorating steadily since it won the contract in 1970.

Students were so disgusted after salmonella outbreak that about 60 of them

dumped their supper on the table one night and left the dining hall en masse.

It is not yet known whether any students are considering lawsuits against Versafood because of the outbreak; nor is it known if any students suffered academically because of the illness.

Versafood, an American based corporation, will have its contract with the University coming up for review soon.

Winter Carnival Variety Show

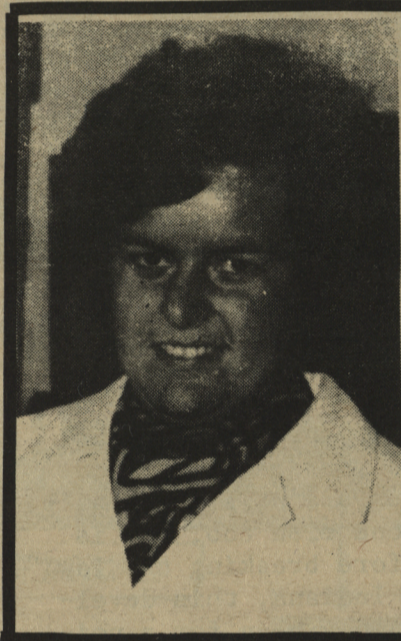
