

SU as a whole -Sit on at least one SU committee during office tenure

SENATORS, BOARD OF GOVERNORS STUDENT REP., MAPUS SENATE REP.: The student representative on the Board of Governors and the five Senate reps. shall: -Serve a one year term from the date elected. -Act as Governors or Senators of the University -Be a member of Council with regular duties of Councillors

OMBUDSPERSON: The Ombudsperson shall: -Be elected for a one year term -Endeavour to aid any member of the UPEISU who encounters difficulties with the University and/or the UPEISU -Inform students as to what recourse are available for prominent student concerns on campus and publicize these recourse through campus media -Be a non-voting member of council -Be entitled to attend any meeting of the UPEISU including meetings which are ordinarily considered confidential, such as Hiring and Selection, Executive, or special investigatory meetings. - Be entitled access to the files, business reports and financial records of the UPEISU -Not assume any other position on campus during office tenure

CLASS EXECUTIVES: SENIOR: Senior class executive shall be responsible for organizing activities and raising funds for Senior Week of their graduating year.

ALL OTHER CLASS EXECUTIVES: shall raise money to plan for their graduating year. Junior class also assists with Senior Week activities.
