Emergency Medical Situations on Campus

Occasionally, an accident or medical emergency occurs on campus involving a student, a faculty or staff person, or a member of the public visiting the University. These occasions arise despite the hour of the day or the day of the week.

Thus, the purpose of this communication is to advise faculty and staff on the process to follow for emergency situations that may arise on campus.

If you identify any individual in a medical crisis (for example, injury or accident, seizure, fainting spell, asthmatic attack, chest pain), call the Security Department at 566-0384. A Security Officer will be dispatched to your area. All the Security Officers are trained in First Aid measures and CPR techniques.

The Security Officer will assess the situation and implement further measures as required, including suggesting or assisting the individual to access medical care or call an ambulance. Your role will be to assist the Security Officer as he/she directs.

Eligibility: A student must be enrolled or accepted for enrolment as a full time law student at an accredited university law school for the academic year 1999-2000. Proof of enrolment or acceptance for enrolment for the 1999-2000 academic year must accompany the application.

Method of Selection: A committee selected by the Council of Law Society of Prince Edward Island shall determine the recipients of the scholarship each year.

Criteria: Awarding of the scholarship is based on scholastic attainment in the previous one (1) year of academic study and demonstrated financial need.
