## Russia Next To U.S. In World Sea Power

LONDON (AP)—The Soviet Union has moved in behind the United States as the world's second naval power and is pressing Japan for merchant-marine leadership.

These conclusions were reached by Jane's Fighting Ships, the accepted authority on maritime affairs, in its report for 1966-67.

Facts collected by the 69-year-old organization show that while Russia has no aircraft carriers, it outstrips the United States in conventional submarines. The U.S.S.R. lags in nuclear-powered submarines, however.

#### Board Takes Scrooge View In Tax Case

OTTAWA (CP)—In a judgment that might have extended Scrooge, the tax appeal board Tuesday upheld a federal claim to \$9,875.66 in succession duties resulting from a sweepstakes win on Santa Claus.

Gordon Moore Andrews, the Ottawa man who held the Irish Sweepstakes ticket, became fatally ill shortly after the \$150,000 win in 1964 and died five months later.

His son and two daughters argued that it had been a family tradition to contribute four ways to a ticket marked Luck of the Irish, which was drawn in 1964 on a horse called Santa Claus.

The unwritten understanding was that any amount won would be divided among the father and his three children.

However, federal revenue argued successfully that the shares that went to the children were a gift within three years of death and thus taxable as an inheritance.

late Mr. Andrews, about to enter hospital, assigned to his son Eric all rights to the winning \$2.50 ticket.

**DIVIDED WINNINGS**  
On his father's instructions, Eric later distributed quarter shares of \$37,287.52 to his father, two sisters and himself.

Federal lawyers argued that "in the absence of documentary evidence, the allegation of an old and continuing declaration of trust had not been established."

The tax appeal board found it "an inescapable fact" that the father "voluntarily transferred" 75 per cent of his interest to the children as a gift.

That made them heirs rather than winners of \$37,287.52 each and opened the way for succession duties.

#### TRAWLERS SAID SPIES

A 20-year program by the U.S.S.R. now has culminated in its "mating" submarines, cruisers, destroyers, escorts, support ships, minesweepers, guided-missile patrol boats, oilers, store carriers and electronic surveillance scouts (usually fishing trawlers) with anything that the other major naval powers can produce.

Jane's estimated Soviet strength at 40 nuclear powered submarines, 340 conventional submarines, 20 cruisers, 110 destroyers, 100 escorts, 300 coastal escorts, 300 minesweepers, 100 missile patrol boats, 350 torpedo boats and 200 landing craft.

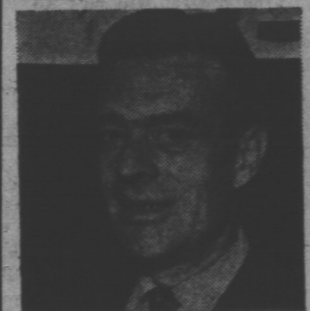
Auxiliaries and other surface craft, often disguised as part of the merchant fleet, run into the thousands.

The United States is aiming for an entirely nuclear-powered fleet by the 1970s and meanwhile has a force of 3,400 units. These include 60 carriers or types that can be so used, 207 submarines, 38 heavy and light cruisers, 670 destroyers or escorts, 220 mine-laying and mine-sweeping vessels plus hundreds of service boats that include high-speed Mosquitos now in use off the shores of Vietnam.

**BIG ON CARRIERS**  
The American plan for more nuclear-powered aircraft carriers envisages a "force of first line aircraft carriers right up to the end of the century," Jane's reported. It said the United States plans a striking force of 15 giant carriers capable of carrying on almost indefinitely.

In contrast, Jane's wrote that the once mighty British navy is dependent over the cancellation of a proposed new carrier of 50,000 tons.
