11 a.m., too.

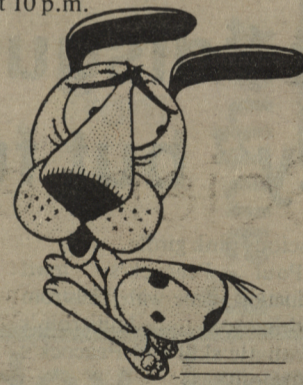
