

CNR Savings Bond Drive Shows Increase This Year

MONCTON, N.B., Oct. 27 —The first week of campaigning among Canadian National Railways employees for the eighth series Canada Savings Bonds, resulted in 4,159 employees subscribing an average, 2,870 employees subscribing vice-president and general manager, Atlantic Region of the Railway, said here today.

Equivalent figures for the last series of Canada Saving Bonds were 2,370 employees subscribing an amount of \$590,150 or an increase of 1,589 subscribers and \$346,050 in amount.

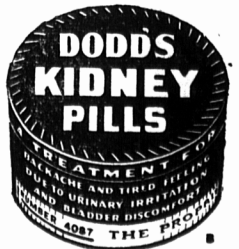
GOOD SIDELINE
