As it glides in the shadow and sheen!

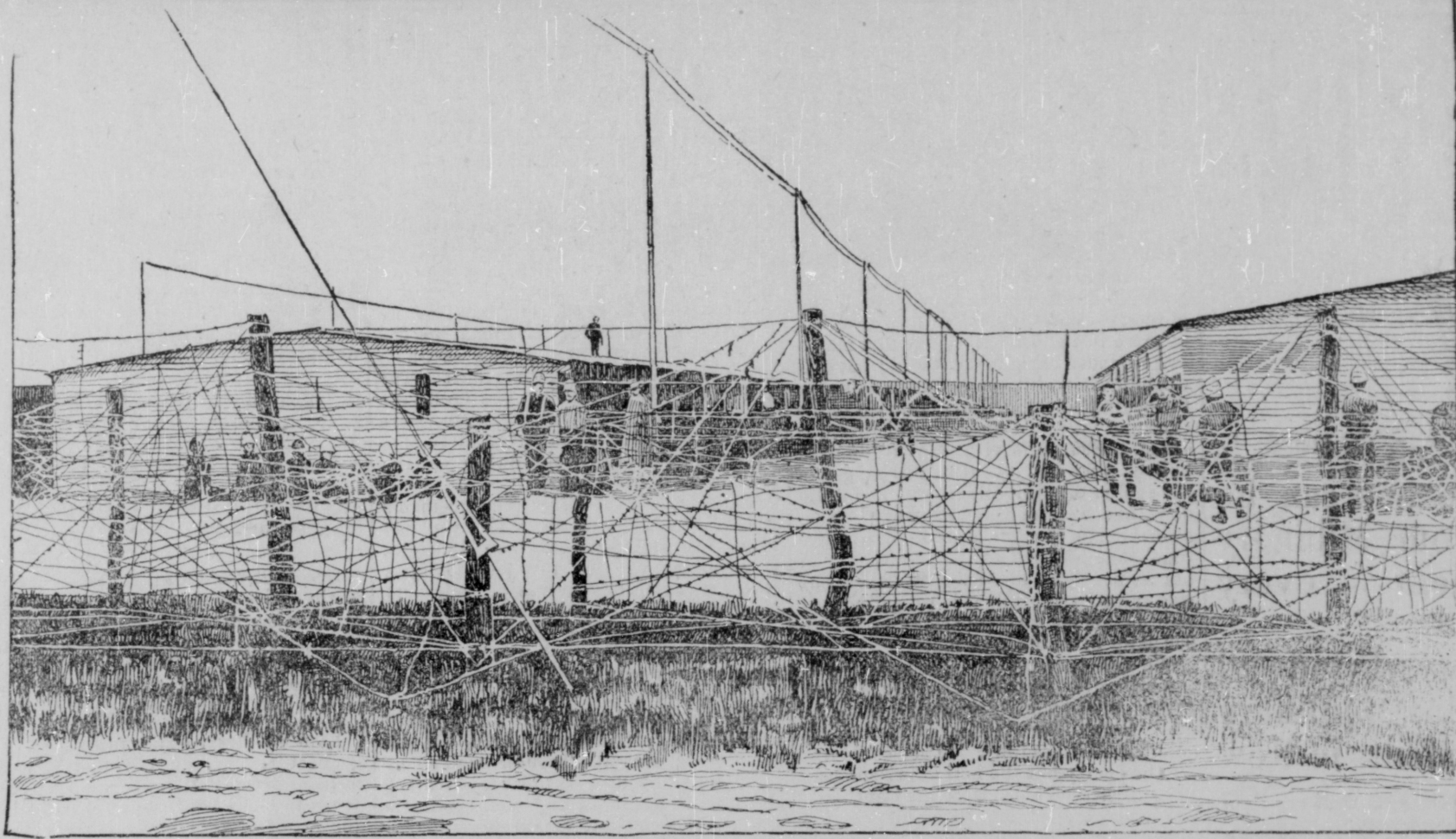
There is a magical isle up the River of Time,


