Mushrooming Sales Challenge Farm Giants

WINNIPEG (CP)—A Winnipeg firm which emphasizes specialization has challenged the giants of the farm implement industry and plans further expansion.

Sales of Versatile Manufacturing Limited mushroomed from about \$2,000,000 in 1962 to more than \$9,000,000 in 1964. An addition to the Winnipeg plant is planned for 1966.

The company which claims to be the world's largest producer of swathers plans production of combines in 1966.

Vice-President Roy E. Robinson reported he had orders for 650 combines for 1965, but could fill only 600.

Peter Pakosh, 33, president of Versatile, predicts production of more than 4,000 combines a year by 1970.

DESIGNED FOR FARMING
Mr. Pakosh says specialization is an important reason for success. Unlike larger companies, Versatile concentrates on making equipment specifically designed for grain farming.

Versatile sold 60 per cent of the 5,000 swathers it produced last year in 11 U.S. States. About 40 per cent of Versatile production is sold in the U.S.

In 1945, Mr. Pakosh was a draftsman working for a Mas-

sey-Ferguson predecessor. Not willing to wait for a chance to work into a job involving actual design, he designed and built a farm sprayer.

He went into partnership with his brother-in-law Roy Robinson and, working in a small Toronto shop, sold to farmers in Western Canada.

In 1959 the company moved to Winnipeg to defray freight

costs and to be nearer the market area.

The partners founded allied companies each producing different lines of machinery to get a tax break.

In 1963, the companies amalgamated under the name Versatile Manufacturing, started building a \$2,000,000 plant and went to the public with 920,000 common shares. The plant has been completed.

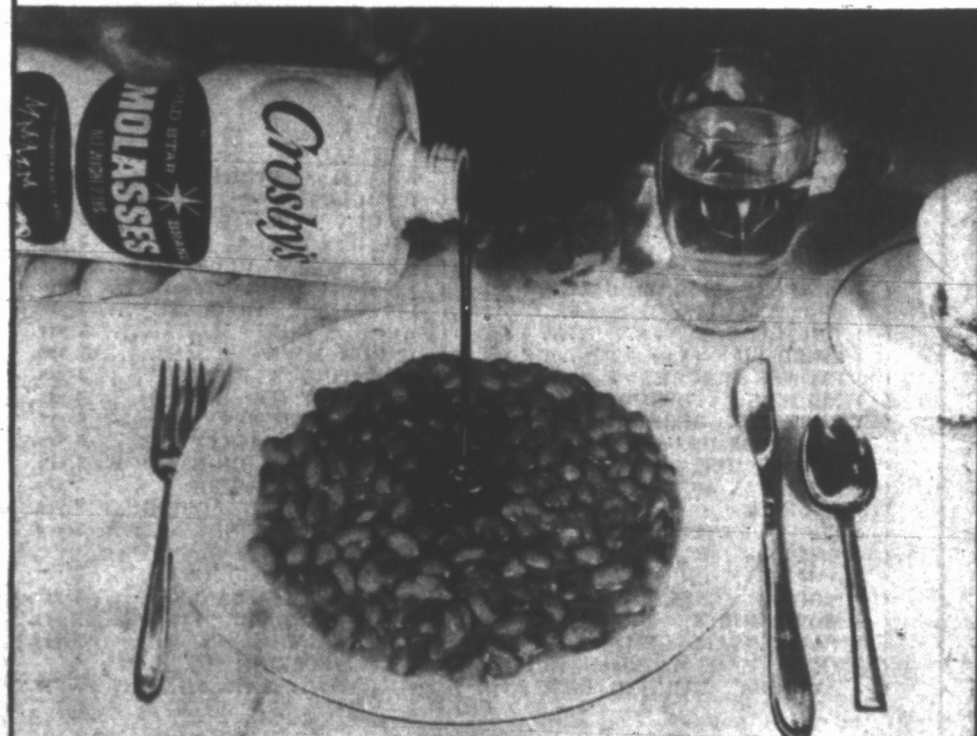
