WINNIPEG (CP) - Late weakness on U.S. grain markets Tuesday brought liquidation in Winnipeg grains and advances scored earlier in the session were reduced or erased at the close.  
Parcel lots of barley apparently went to the United Kingdom and there also was processing demand. Seaboard houses took flax on fair offerings.  
Overnight export loadings of Canadian wheat included United Kingdom 410,000 bushels, Colombia 30,000, The Netherlands 15,000 and Belgium 100,000.  
Class two wheat prices were unchanged. Top grades of IWA and domestic durum advanced 1/4 cent but prices were unchanged in other grades.

**New York Stocks**  
NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market ran into intense selling just before the close Tuesday, and prices were hammered back abruptly. The decline was sudden and substantial but there was no acute weakness uncovered.  
The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was down 90 cents at \$147.30. Volume amounted to 3,440,000 shares.  
Allegheny Corp. was the day's most active issue unchanged at 65 on 89,200 shares. It was followed by New York Central off 1-4 at 25 5/8 and Boeing up 1-4 at 64 3-4.  
Zenith Radio was hit hard by selling and lost 8 points at 86 3-4 after directors declared the usual dividend.  
Among stocks losing ground were Royal Dutch Petroleum, Texas Gulf Producing, L. S. Starrett, Allegheny Ludlum Steel, U.S. Steel, Goodrich, Caterpillar Tractor, DuPonts Corp., Admiral Corp., American Telephone & Telegraph, Copper, Union Carbide, Santa Fe, Southern Pacific, Standard Oil N. J., Gulf Oil, Kern County Land, Pan American World Airways and U. S. Gypsum.  
Among stocks resting the lower trend were Douglas Aircraft, Northrop, Chrysler, American Hawaiian Steamship, International Silver, Pittsburgh Consolidation, Cori, Commonwealth Edison, American Tobacco, Chesapeake and Ohio and Armour.  
Canadian stocks were lower. McIntyre and Distillers Seagram both dropped one point. They were followed by International Nickel, off 1-2. Doms Mines advanced 1-4.  
On the American stock exchange, Royaltie Oil eased 1-2, Giant Yellowknife gained 1-4 and Lake Shore added 1-8.

**Montreal Stocks**  
MONTREAL (CP) - Prices were irregularly lower at the close of active trading on the stock market Tuesday.  
Crown Zellerbach was down 2 1/2 points while St. Lawrence Corporation lost 2. Dominion Steel and Imperial Oil were each off 1/2 and CPR lost 1-2. Quarter-point losses were shown by Aluminium, International Nickel and Donohue. Canadian Industries was off 1/4.  
Industrial Acceptance gained 1/4 while Canada Cement, Bathurst B and McColl were each 1-2 stronger. Famous Players and Canadian Breweries each firmed 1/4.  
Papers, senior metals and steels lost strength while miscellaneous industrials were irregularly higher. The remainder of the industrial section was narrowly mixed.  
Mines showed a mixed tendency with Meta gaining 9 cents and East Sullivan off 15 cents. Quebec Nickel lost 4 cents. In western oils, Sapphirer advanced 10 cents while Calgary moved off 10 cents.
