LEGENDS AND TRADITIONS OF THE ST. LAWRENCE

THE EXAMINER is indebted to Sir James M. Lemoyne, K. M. G., late President of the Royal Society of Canada, for advance copy of a volume of Canadian folk-lore of exceptional interest which he is bringing out under the above title, 203 pages 2m. 8vo. Sir James, as our readers are aware, is the only writer of the Dominion on whom Her Majesty has conferred the honor of knighthood for industrious and successful literary labour in the domain of Canadian annals.

The collection is said to owe its origin to legends of our French Bretons, picked up by Jonathan Oldback, (Sir J. M. I.) in course of pleasant cruises in the Lower St. Lawrence on board the swift winged yacht Hirondele. There are thirty legends in all, but these are embedded in a mosaic of graphic and graceful word-painting, illusions to features of old and romantic scenes zone by zone, with glimpses of sport and adventure, all related in cheery after-dinner gossip.

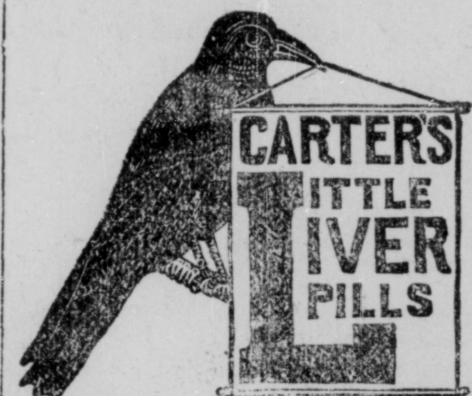
