NEW YORK (AP)—The 1963 stock market rally kept rolling Friday with volume at the heaviest since Monday's turbulent year-end session. Reinvestment of funds made available by taxless selling and profit taking, as well as the commitment of money which brokers said was "waiting on the sidelines," were credited for running the advance through its second session.

NEW YORK (Cont.)
The Dow Jones industrial average rose 4.81 to 622.23, an over-rose to 5,400,000 shares. The associated Price average of 60 stocks rose 1.8 to 248.4. Brunswick was the volume leader dropping 1/4 to 19 1/8 on 89,000 shares.

NEW YORK (Cont.)
Chrysler was up 1/4 at 75 1/4 and an Scurry Raincoat Co. share changed at 1/4. American Motors was up 1/4 at 17 1/4 and American Oil at 11 1/4. U.S. Smelting was actively traded and ran up 3/4 despite general denting of anything, especially bullish in the wind.

NEW YORK (Cont.)
IBM up 1/2 to 161 1/4 as it failed to hold the lion's share of its gain and closed at 307 for a net gain of 1/4. Another volatile issue, Polaroid, rose 1/4. General American Oil, which advanced 3/4 Thursday amid rumors of merger or an asset sale, fell 2 1/4 as the rumor was officially denied.

NEW YORK (Cont.)
Among other auto stocks, General Motors gained 1/4 to 59 1/4, another record high for GM, while Ford closed unchanged and Studebaker gained 1/4. Prices rose on the American Stock Exchange as volume increased to 1,800,000 shares from 840,000 Thursday. Canadian Marconi was up 1/4, Preston 3/8 and Scurry Raincoat 1/4.
