

# Polio Vaccination

This is the first in a series of inoculations of Salk vaccine which is based on a regular Gault vaccine and adapted to the procedure by the co-operation of the P. E. I. Department of Public Health and Welfare.

How can you obtain the Salk vaccine for your children? The announcement that the vaccine has been proven effective, a question, I'm sure, is uppermost in the minds of most parents.

The National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis has already solved the problem for many through foresight, the March of Dimes Foundation has purchased 1,000,000 worth of the protective vaccine. This is enough to inoculate approximately 9,000,000 children.

**PROGRAM UNDER WAY**

In the U. S. A. with Federal assistance of the vaccine by the National Institute of Health, the mass inoculation program began almost immediately. The polio vaccine will furnish the Salk vaccine free to the following children:

All youngsters now enrolled in the first and second grades of all public, private and parochial schools in the 48 states, the District of Columbia, and Hawaii and Alaska.

OTTAWA (CP) - The Victorian Order of Nurses' quinquennial appeal for funds has raised more than \$750,000, E. P. Taylor of Toronto, president, told the order's annual meeting Thursday.
