WHITE GRUBS HEALTH

The last serious outbreak of White Grubs (June beetle) in Prince Edward Island was in 1933. Various minor outbreaks have since occurred in widely separated areas. As these destructive insects have a three-year life-cycle, there is good reason to expect that the summer season of 1936 will see these insects very abundant, and that they will do much damage to crops in the neighbourhood of previous outbreaks and in certain territory adjacent to these areas of former infestation.

British Liberal Party To Reorganize

LONDON, May 1 - (C. P. Cable) - Complete reorganization of the British Liberal Party, with the fighting forces of Liberalism coordinated to contest every electoral division in England and Wales, was forehadowed in the report of the Liberal reorganization commission published tonight.
The commission, which conducted its survey under the chairmanship of Lord Meston, expressed the view that Liberalism in the United Kingdom has survived its worst trials and its revival was assured.
The report recommended no change should be made in the name of the party, and that provision should be made for the organization of local and regional associations with a powerful central body at the head.

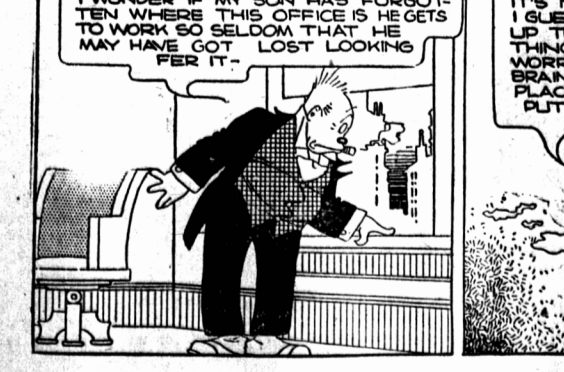
Duke of Connaught On King's Personal Staff

LONDON, May 1 - (C. P. Cable) - The King has appointed his great-uncle, the Duke of Connaught, to be the first of his personal aides-de-camp. The appointment is effective as from Friday, the Duke's 88th birthday.
Another mark of esteem was accorded the Duke, the only living son of Queen Victoria and former Governor General of Canada, when he was proclaimed Grand Master of the United Grand Lodge of Freemasons for the 35th time.
His Royal Highness is stated to be in excellent health. Recently he made a thorough inspection of the liner Queen Mary.

AUSTRALIAN CARS AIR-CONDITIONED

VICTORIA, N. S. W., May 1. - (CP) - Within the next year all railway coaches in the state of Victoria will be fully air-conditioned; H. W. Clapp, chairman of the state railway commissioners, announced here.
Tests of first air-conditioned cars have proven successful. Trial journey in temperature 100 above zero showed the new cars remained cool and comfortable. Dust and draft were fully eliminated.
