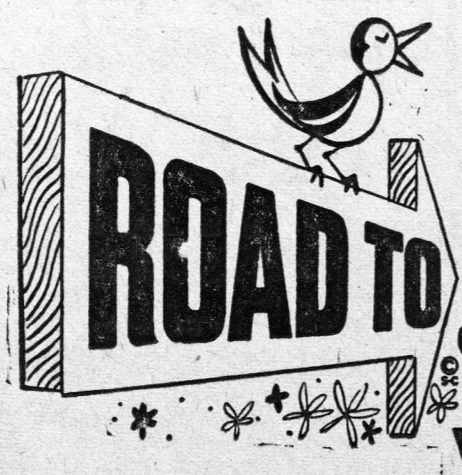
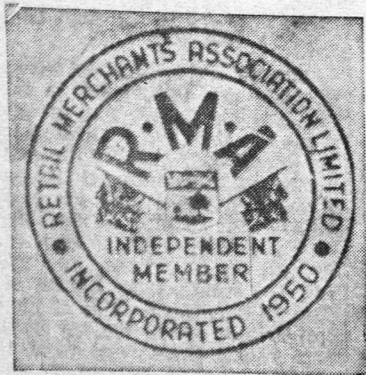
Prayer Service At Crapaud
