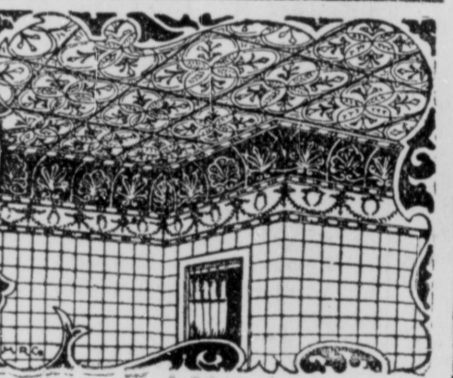
While at the hospital I saw some wounded Boer prisoners, among whom was Commandant Pretorius. I spoke to him and he said:

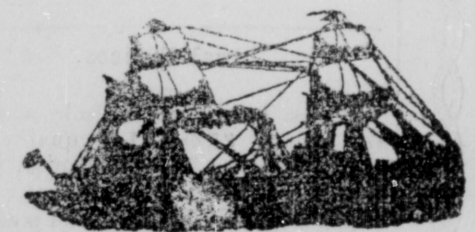
