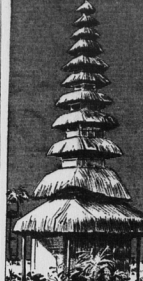

CHATHAM, N.B. (CP) — A F-102 jet training aircraft from the RCAF station here crashed Thursday four miles south of Chipman in central New Brunswick but the two occupants parachuted safely and were re-

turned to Chatham by a station helicopter.
An air force announcement said the cause of the accident is unknown and under investigation.
