

Some Easing Of Tension Apparent In Middle East

In diplomacy's talk, a detente means a lessening of tension in an international crisis. After the earlier mad rush of events, that seemed to describe the situation in the Middle East this week.

None of the big questions had been answered. But the cease-fire was holding. Diplomacy and the emergency peace force of the United Nations were taking hold. Moscow reports that Egypt had formally requested the aid of Soviet "volunteers"—aid the Russians had said was available for the asking—caused a flurry of ex-

citement. But subsequent Moscow dispatches discounted any immediate activity in that direction.

BIG QUESTION MARK
The first contingents of the UN emergency force—Danes, Norwegians and Colombians in bright blue helmets and wearing UN arm-bands—reached Egypt. Dag Hammarskjöld secretary-general of the UN, flew into Cairo to confer with President Nasser.

Presumably Hammarskjöld is tackling personally the big question mark of the situation: How to reconcile the seemingly irreconcilable positions of Egypt on one hand and the French-British allies on the other.

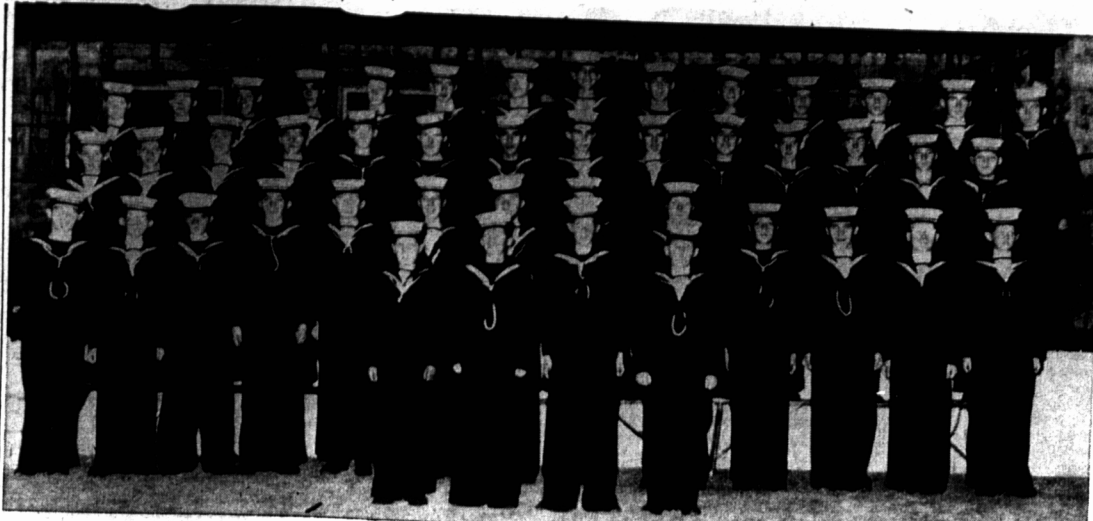
Nasser sees the UN force as supervising a British-French withdrawal from the Canal zone, then moving out of Egypt to the Egyptian-Israeli armistice lines and leaving the canal in Egyptian hands. Britain and France insist the UN force must take over the canal zone until its future as an international waterway can be worked out.

HUNGARIANS DEFIANT
The military end of the Hungarian insurrection seemed to be ended—for now anyway. But a political tug-of-war continued, and workers kept life practically at a standstill by staying away from their jobs.

A spirit of patriotic defiance made it tough for the Russian-backed Kadar regime. Kadar tried to strengthen his position by getting Imre Nagy back into the government.

Nagy, in refuge at the Yugoslav Embassy in Budapest, would have none of it. He is the so-called Titoist premier under whom the Hungarian nationalist uprising nearly succeeded. Then the Russians doublecrossed him, installed the puppet Kadar and with overwhelming military force crushed the rebellion.

EDEN SUPPORTED
The volume of criticism and abuse that descended on the head of Sir Anthony Eden after the British-French action against Egypt was without precedent in the history of the world.

This week even the Labor opposition conceded public opinion has come round to Sir Anthony's support. And in a by-election at Chester, the Conservatives won. The government majority was lower but that is normal in by-elections.

IKK'S STAND
The U.S. presidential election out of the way, the world looked to Washington for some declaration of American policy in the Middle East crisis.

President Eisenhower gave the answer. It was a cautious answer. He said the U.S. would oppose through the UN any Russian intervention. The U.S. would take no unilateral military action. He emphasized the UN has more effective ways of opposing aggression than the passing of resolutions.

CANADIAN CONTINGENT
Canada's contribution to the UN emergency force is ready to embark. The 1st Battalion, Queen's Own Rifles, completed its move to the Middle East aboard the aircraft carrier Magnificent, or by airlift should a hurry-up call be received.

Prime Minister St. Laurent cautioned that the Canadian troops have not yet been committed to the UN. By that he meant they
