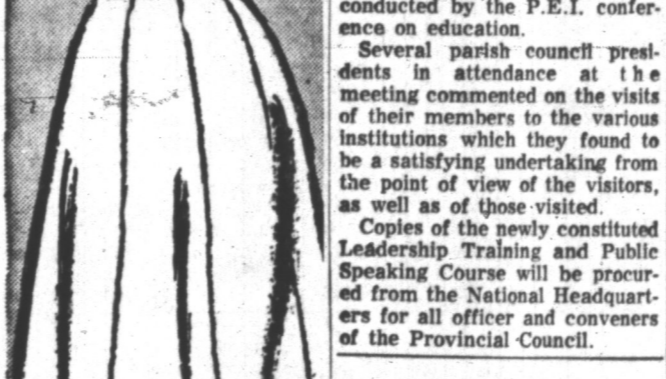
Vitamin And Mineral Pills Declared Useless For Most
