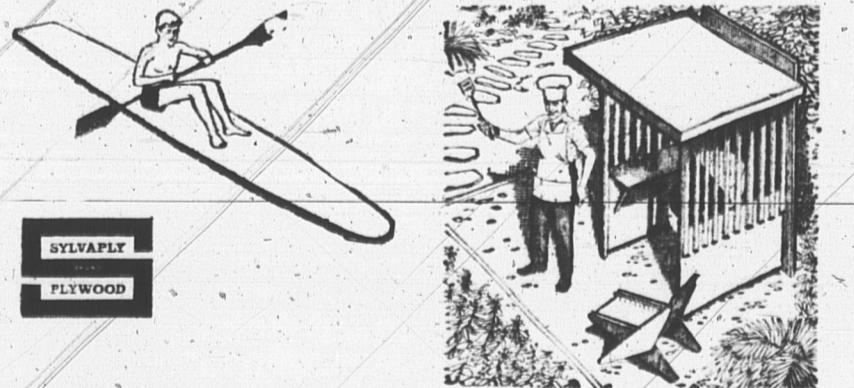
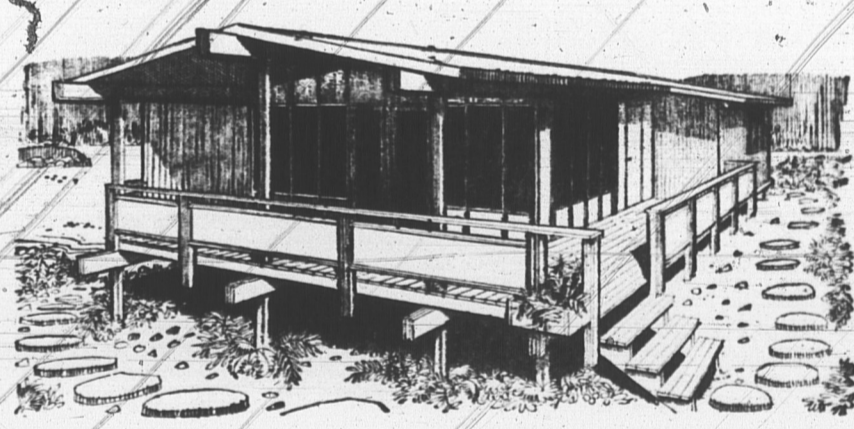
Hay Competition Available, Feeding Advice Is Confusing
