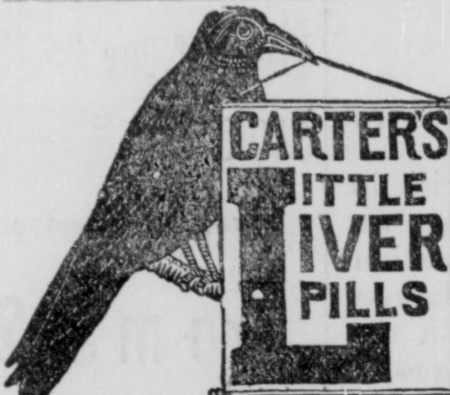

Primitive Man.

Quite recently some skulls and skeletons of races contemporary in France with the reindeer have been discovered, and they have afforded material for the above conclusion. The characteristics of the animal, the low forehead and the projecting mouth disappear in man's conflict with circumstances. Mental labor of course develops the brain, and the forehead becomes upright and the projecting countenance recedes under the skull. It is also the belief among scientists that the primeval Europeans were cannibals and inferior, in spite of their white skins, to the lowest type of existing savagery—the Australian bushman. All this chain of deductions and much more were recently made at a paleontological congress in Copenhagen.—New York Times.

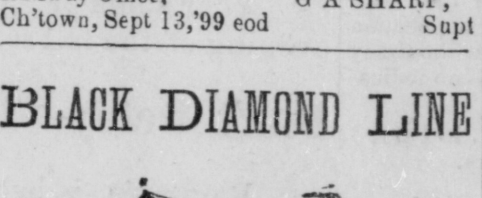
