North Koreans Claim Victories

LONDON, Aug. 2 (AP) - Communist North Korea claimed its troops have "annihilated" the 24th Division of the United States Eighth Army plus 50,000 South Korean soldiers.

In a broadcast story dated from Pyongyang, the North Korean capital, the Communist New China News Agency said:

"With the loss of one entire division the Americans have now only the 25th Division and a few artillery units left, amounting to 17,000 men in all."

The story declared that "at no time since their engaging in a ground force the American 'air and ground forces manifested any will to fight."

It said the morale of the North Korean troops is high "while the U.S. mercenaries are fighting without any conviction."
