MONTAGUE—Trinity United Church, Montague, will observe the 83rd anniversary of the dedication of the church for the worship of God, this coming Sunday.

This church was built and dedicated as a Presbyterian Church in 1876. The United Church was formed on June 10, 1925.

The anniversary service will be held at 11 a.m. and 7.30 p.m. with Rev. Stanley G. MacQueen, B.A., of First United Church Truro, N.S., as special speaker.
