

Fatalities On Holiday Weekend Set New Record

A record 122 Canadians died accidentally during the three-day Labor Day weekend, including 76 in traffic accidents. The previous record of 121 was established in 1963.

A Canadian Press survey from 8 p.m. Friday to midnight Monday, local times, showed 23 Canadians also died in drowning accidents, six in fires and 25 in miscellaneous accidents.

It marked the fourth consecutive year Labor Day fatalities have exceeded 100. The Canadian Highway Safety Council predicted prior to the holiday weekend 75 Canadians would die in traffic accidents. Quebec reported 37 fatalities, including 33 traffic deaths, 18 drownings and six in miscellaneous accidents. Ontario reported 22, of which 14 occurred in traffic, three drownings, one fire and four in other accidents. N.B. HARD HIT

New Brunswick reported 13 deaths, six in traffic, four in fires and three by other causes. Saskatchewan, British Columbia and Newfoundland each reported six holiday deaths while Alberta reported five, Nova Scotia four and Manitoba three. Prince Edward Island had a fatality-free holiday weekend.

The survey does not include industrial or natural deaths or known suicides or slayings. The Quebec highway toll prompted Joseph Brunet, director general of the provincial police, to say his force would have to station officers at half-mile intervals, along all Quebec highways to reduce the toll on holiday weekends.

He called for stricter application of traffic laws and said traffic violators must be dealt with severely. There appeared no other solution.

His 2,650-man force is not large enough to launch a policeman every half-mile campaign, he added.

Steel Industry Peace Assured In U.S. 35 Months

PITTSBURGH (AP) — The signatures are on a new contract and labor peace in the American basic steel industry is guaranteed for 35 months.

The agreement, which was negotiated last week in Washington under constant prodding from President Johnson, was signed late Monday night by President J. W. Abel of the United Steelworkers union and chief industry negotiator R. Conrad Cooper.

Although the contract has averted what Johnson said would have been an economy-harming strike, it remains to be seen if it will lead to an increase in steel prices either on a general or selective basis. The pact, approved by the union's wage policy committee Monday, provides an hourly increase of almost 50 cents in wages and benefits for some 450,000 steelworkers.

The new contract, which runs to Aug. 1, 1966, provides for increased earnings and benefits estimated by the union at 47.3 cents an hour. The government estimated the raises at 49 cents an hour. The industry was reported to have placed an even higher price tag on them, but Cooper declined to comment.

Under the old contract steelworkers already were among the nation's highest paid industrial workers in the U.S., averaging \$4.40 an hour in wages and benefits.

New Daily Published

HULL, Que. (CP) — A new daily newspaper, Hull-Matin, appeared for the first time Tuesday.

The tabloid-size French-language daily proposed to devote itself to the interests of western Quebec province and serve an area of 125,000 population, from Aylmer to Montebello and from the Ottawa River to Wakefield. Hull itself, across the Ottawa River from Canada's capital, has a population of 72,000.

The publisher, Roland LaFrance, said Hull has no daily and that the president of Hull-Matin already owns three weeklies in the district. Le Bulletin de Rockingham, La Revue de Gatineau and La Vallée de la Petite Nation.

The president of the new daily is Gerard Bonicazzi. The first issue had 24 pages and sold for 10 cents a copy.

URGENT AGING COURSES TORONTO (CP) — Middle-aged persons should be offered extension courses on old age, the Baptist Convention of Ontario and Quebec has told the Ontario legislature's select committee on aging. The convention said middle-aged persons must be taught to prepare for the problems that come with old age, and urged greater privacy and a more homey atmosphere in homes for senior citizens.
