Army Short Of Manpower, Officials Say

OTTAWA (CP)—Will the 1st Battalion, Canadian Guards, have to rush off on a United Nations peace-keeping mission still wearing their red coats and bearskin hats?

The defence department is keeping its fingers crossed that the UN won't make a new call for a Canadian contingent this summer.

It announced Wednesday that the 1st Guards on June 28 will begin the daily changing of the guard ceremony on Parliament Hill, a prime tourist attraction in the capital.

It had announced earlier that the 1st Guards will take over July 1 as Canada's UN standby battalion.

The fact that this country's UN standby unit will be performing a ritual for tourists at a time when External Affairs Minister Martin is saying that UN peace-keeping is the "wave of the future" has many officials here, especially in the foreign ministry, hopping with anger.

One said Canada's whole peace-keeping effort will be held up to ridicule.

HAS TOO FEW MEN

Defence department informants said, however, that, with all its other commitments, the army is running short of infantry battalions.

The 2nd Guards are scheduled to join the UN force in Cyprus in September if the UN mandate there is renewed by the Security Council. The 2nd Guards have never received peace-keeping training. They are under strength and will have to be fleshed out by men from the 1st Guards.

Officials said the 1st Guards, with their six months' experience in Cyprus, could take on a peace-keeping job for the UN at short notice.

In such an event, the changing of the guard ceremony, scheduled to continue until Sept. 7, would have to be halted.

Soviet Charges Against Attache Are Repudiated

OTTAWA (CP)—The Canadian government repudiates the allegations made against Col. Curtis Greenleaf, Canadian military attache in Moscow, by the Russian newspaper Izvestia, External Affairs Minister Martin said Wednesday.

Mr. Martin, replying to Opposition House Leader Starr, said in the Commons that Canadian Ambassador R. A. D. Ford's attention was drawn to the allegations Monday by the Russian foreign ministry.

Mr. Ford, having had an opportunity to assess Col. Greenleaf's work and character, immediately took issue with the suggestions of the Russian foreign ministry, Mr. Martin said. He reiterated that the government has the fullest confidence in Col. Greenleaf. There was no basis whatsoever, according to the information supplied Ottawa, for the Izvestia allegations.

The newspaper accused Col. Greenleaf of "boozing" after a drinking party.

Mr. Starr, who questioned Mr. Martin Tuesday about the Izvestia report, asked Wednesday whether the government intends to protest to the Russian government since Izvestia is a government newspaper.

Doyle Is Given Right To Appeal

NEW YORK (CP)—The U.S. circuit court of appeals Wednesday granted John C. Doyle, chairman of Canadian Javelin Ltd., the right to appeal a three-month sentence for illegally mailing unregistered stocks and set bail of \$10,000 pending the appeal.

Doyle's lawyers are appealing a three-month sentence imposed on Doyle after he had pleaded guilty to a charge of mailing unregistered stock in the United States in 1957.

Doyle, 40, a Canadian now legally resident in the Bahamas, was to begin serving his sentence next Monday. The appeal is scheduled in mid-June.

The Appeals Court, Wednesday took issue with a statement made Monday in Hartford, Conn., by Judge Emmett Clarke who stated: "Doyle's motion for appeal is denied because it is frivolous."

The three-judge appeals court sitting in New York City said the appeal was not frivolous and took issue with the prosecution for denying Doyle a speedy trial.

Doyle was indicted on July 2, 1962, but at the government request, the indictment was kept sealed until September, 1963.

SHIFTA SHOOT MERU'S

NAIROBI, Kenya (AP)—Shifty rebels armed with automatic weapons attacked Isola Monday night only hours after a visit to the town by Kenya's minister of commerce and industry, Dr. Julius Kiara. They killed two Meru tribesmen and wounded eight others. The Shiftas, Somali nomads, have been waging sporadic guerrilla war for two years to wrest the arid northern region from Kenya and join it to neighboring Somalia.
