British Bachelor Doctor Taken Into Custody In Murder Case

EASTBOURNE, England (AP)—Amid detective story trappings of fog and mystery, police arrested a bachelor doctor Wednesday on a charge of murdering a wealthy widow who died at 81 in her lonely mansion six years ago. The doctor, Dr. James Bodkin Adams, 57, a portly bespectacled practitioner of Irish birth, was already knee-deep in trouble with the law. His troubles arose after Scotland Yard launched an investigation last summer of the wills of nearly 300 well-to-do old women who died during the last 20 years at this Victorian resort town on the English Channel.
