GRAIN

WINNIPEG, July 23—Heavy export business, estimated at 2,500,000 bushels, marked today's session at Winnipeg grain exchange as wheat futures prices closed 1 3/4 to 1 1/2 cents higher.

July futures finished at 94 1/2-October 94 and December 83 1/4-cents a bushel. In the course of the day practically all early support was credited to export houses and some hesitancy was apparent. Unexpected strength at Chicago, however, proved a big factor in the upturn and induced good buying for southern and foreign account in later stages.

Good inquiry developed for nearly all classifications in the cash wheat market with trades negotiated at generally improved spreads.

In the course of the day, good buying credited to domestic interests appeared in oats, while barley was erratic but showed strength under moderate buying. All coarse grain futures had a firm appearance in sympathy with the movement of wheat values.

The franc slipped .00 11-16 of a cent in New York. The Dutch guilder dropped .09 of a cent. Swiss franc fell .01 of a cent and the pound sterling lost 1-2 of a cent. The Canadian dollar reduced its discount from 3-32 to 1-32 of one per cent. Far eastern currencies were soft. The Japanese yen lost .02 of a cent. Shanghai dollars dropped .05 1-4 of a cent and Hong Kong dollars yielded 55 1-4 of a cent.

Graded egg shipments in carlots or less were quoted at 25 cents a dozen for A large, 22 to 23 for A medium, 21 1-2 to 22 for B and 20 to 21 for C. New Quebec potatoes were quoted at \$1.26 to \$1.35 per 80 pound bag. Cheese averaged 13 3-8 to 5-8 cents for Ontario white and colored and 13 for Quebec white and 13 1-8 to 1-4 for colored.
