TYRONE POWER STARS IN POWERFUL DRAMA CAPITOL SUMMERSIDE

Another spectacular Cinema-Scope production in Technicolor. "King of the Khyber Rifles" with Tyrone Power, Terry Moore and Michael Rennie in the star roles, will have its premiere at the Capitol Theatre today.

"King of the Khyber Rifles" is a romantic adventure story based on a novel by Talbot Mundy and its action takes place in India during the hundredth year of British rule. British soldiers and wild Afridi tribesmen fight their way up and down mountains through India's Khyber Pass and across deserts to provide a picturesque background.

Many of the picture's dramatic sequences were taken from actual happenings, such as the undisciplined native troops refusing to use cartridges suspected of contamination with pig fat; the killing of captives tied to stakes by mounted lancers; and Queen Victoria's Birthday Ball at the Peshwar, India, garrison.

Tyrone Power, returning to his home movie grounds at Twentieth Century-Fox after a triumphant stage tour in "John Brown's Body", plays Captain King, a half-caste British soldier given command of the Khyber Rifles by the General, enacted by Michael Rennie. When he makes a hit with the General's daughter, played by Terry Moore, he begins to suffer discrimination from the other British officers. His loyalty is put to the test in an ensuing breach with the native leader who is also King's foster brother and childhood playmate. How he resolves the double dilemma of his professional and private lives is the meat of the story, safely entrusted to three top-ranking performers.

JAPANESE G. O. M. DIES

TOKYO (AP)—Yuko Ozaki, 88, Japan's "grand old man" who sent the famous cherry trees to Washington 50 years ago, died Wednesday at his home near Yokohama. Ozaki served 25 consecutive terms in Japan's parliament before being defeated in 1952. While mayor of Tokyo from 1903 to 1912 he sent to Washington as a gift the world-famous cherry trees which now bloom each spring along the Potomac.

Let's Talk It Over

Two or three times now we've read criticisms of the teaching of cooking and other domestic arts in the schools. Recently the art of telephone conversation was included in the condemned items. These things, we are advised, should be left to the parents in the homes. This reminds us of the old copy books intended for the improvement of writing. Pupils were supposed to imitate the top line in their writing of the other lines. Trouble was, pupils generally imitated the line immediately above with the natural result that the writing got progressively worse as the work progressed down the page.

Suppose, for instance, the mother happened to be a poor housekeeper and one of the world's worst cooks. Would you have the girls in the family copy faithfully and painstakingly the faulty techniques of their well-meaning, but utterly incompetent forebear? Suppose the parents are illiterate, inconsiderate, loud persons who carry on a telephone conversation in much the same manner as the winner of a hog-calling contest summons the porkers to his presence. Would you have the offspring continue in their parents' obnoxious ways, not only over the telephone, but everywhere else. Or might it not be a good idea to sandwich in between the Latin irregular verbs and the binomial theorem a few practical hints as to the proper way to approach people, both over the phone, and in other ways?

The technique of approach is one very much valued in the business world. A genius whose manners are brusque and unpolished very often never gets a chance

to exhibit his scholarship. By all means, give Butch his daily rationing of academic abstractions. They will, we hope, sharpen his reasoning power, and enlarge his point of view. But persuading him also to wash behind his ears, in case his parents have neglected this essential factor, is not a bad idea either. And a woman who can cook? Well, you've all heard about one of the smoothest highways to a man's heart! It has been pretty well demonstrated locally that the modern "frills" can be mixed with the sound academic practice of our forefathers without causing mental indigestion.
