

## Stanfield Raps Knuckles Of Two Cabinet Ministers

HALIFAX (CP) — Premier Stanfield rapped the knuckles of two of his cabinet ministers in the legislature Friday because a Motor Vehicle Act charge against one of them was withdrawn.

Mr. Stanfield's remarks were in reply to Opposition Leader Hicks, who said Thursday political pressure was used to clear Lands Minister Levy and A. J. Gorman of New Glasgow of RCMP charges. Mr. Gorman was identified as president of the Pictou County Progressive Conservative Association.

Both men had received summonses for passing a car without a clear view of the road ahead. The premier said Attorney-General Donahoe decided a reprimand was sufficient after Mr. Levy asked him to investigate the charge against him.

"... I believe this was a mistake," the premier said. "I believe that a minister of the Crown must conform to a more rigid standard than a private citizen."

"Such a procedure might have been quite in order where a private citizen was involved."

## Halifax Shows Increase In Cargo Tonnage Handled

OTTAWA (CP) — Waterborne cargo tonnage handled at ports administered by the national harbors slipped to 46,675,000 tons in 1957 from 50,469,000 in 1956, the transport department reported "onday."

Only one of seven eastern ports showed gains, Halifax with five per cent. Deliveries from harbor grain elevators, both privately-owned and administered by the board, totalled 376,000,000 bushels, compared with 470,000,000 in 1956.

All harbors — vessel arrivals, 49,421 (51,583); vessel tonnage, 49,648,800 (50,355,977); cargo tonnage, 46,676,164 (50,469,532).

Halifax — arrivals, 2,938 (2,887); vessel tonnage, 6,650,659 (6,443,407); cargo tonnage, 6,984,312 (6,850,896).

## Add, Not Cubit, But Inches To Adolescents

NEW YORK (AP)—Male sex hormone can stimulate growth to help adolescent boys reach their adult height sooner, medical researchers report.

The treatment is especially helpful for boys who feel psychologically inferior because classmates go towering above them while they remain short.

In adolescence, some boys shoot up in height early while others don't experience the spurt in growth until years later. Tiny daily doses of sex hormone helped produce the growth spurt, Drs. Nancy Baylor, Gilbert S. Gordan and H. Lissner of the University of California school of medicine and national institute of mental health report in the Journal, Pediatric Clinics of North America.

The hormone treatment helped some boys reach this height sooner than they might have otherwise, the researchers said. A few boys became a few inches taller than the predicted height. A few did not reach it.

Forty-seven of 51 boys taking the hormone had prompt spurts in growth. All but a few reached maximum growth in the first year of treatment.

The artificial spurt was induced earlier than in a group of late-maturing boys who were not treated. The boys getting the hormone grew at least as rapidly and for a longer time than those not treated.

A few boys have since become old enough to marry, and there is no evidence the treatment interfered with fertility, the report said. At least five have become fathers.
