

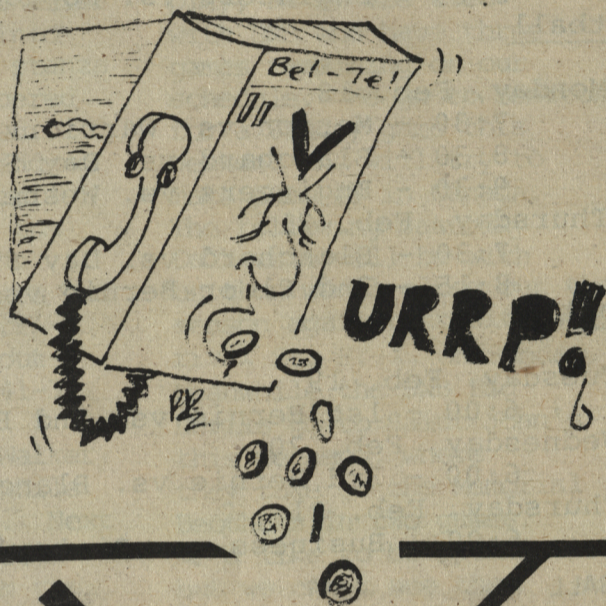
# WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE...
