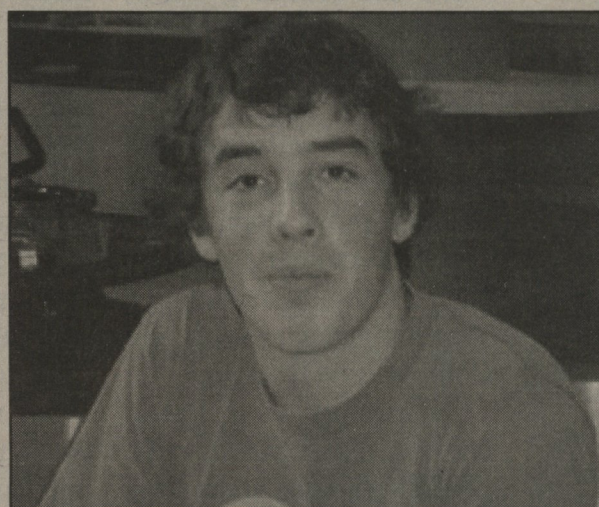


The Cadre asks:

"I think it would be touch to police but not necessarily a bad idea." - Iain McCarvell



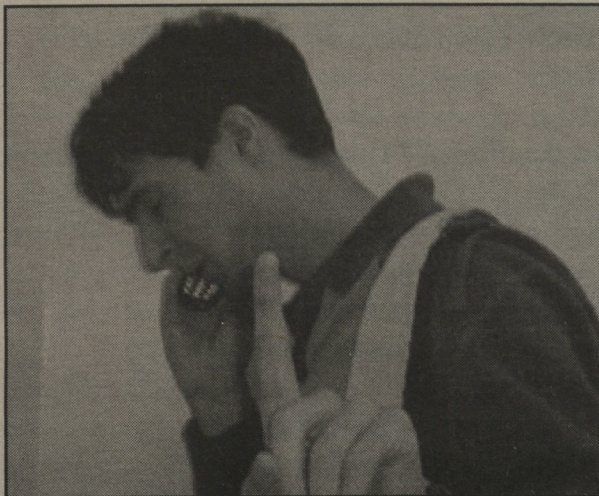
"On one hand it's dangerous but on the other hand it's an inconvenience. I don't know." Ben Hayman, 1st year Arts



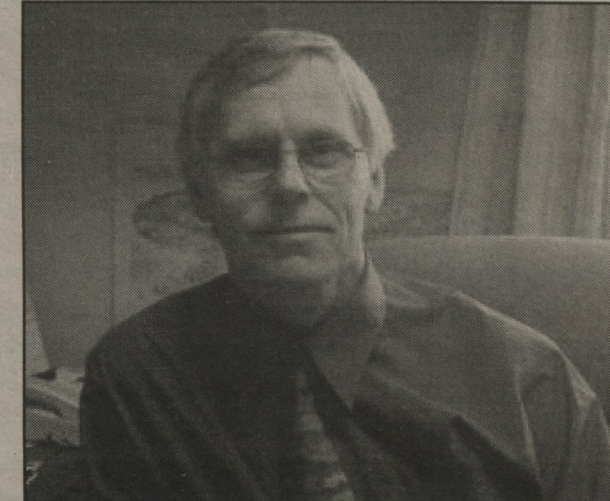
"I can see how you could get distracted when you're in a deep convo. I would suggest headsets being mandatory." - Simone Durville, 2nd year Bunsiness
