

2 NDP Members Ask Probe Of Deportation

OTTAWA (CP)—New Democrat MPs Andrew Brewin and Reid Scott have demanded in a letter to Prime Minister Pearson an immediate judicial inquiry into the handling of deportation proceedings against a man branded by United States authorities as a Mafia lieutenant.

The man is Onofrio Minaudo whose deportation was ordered March 9, 1961, by the Progressive Conservative government but who was not sent out of the country until March 11, 1964.

His criminal record included murder, armed robbery, parole breaking, parole breaking and conspiracy convictions.

Mr. Brewin (Toronto Greenwood) and Mr. Scott (Toronto Danforth) coupled their demand for a judicial inquiry with a demand for a searching revision of the Immigration Act and procedures.

In a statement sent to Mr. Pearson with their letter, they said:

"One question which cries aloud for an answer is this: Who made the decision to let Minaudo stay in Canada?"

HAD FORGOTTEN CASE

They said Mrs. Ellen Fairclough, Progressive Conservative immigration minister from 1960 until 1962, was quoted as saying she could not recall the case.

"Perhaps at a judicial inquiry, Mrs. Fairclough's memory could be refreshed. Surely it was not a routine decision when the normal procedure was overridden and ministerial clemency extended to a man with a record such as Minaudo's."

The statement says F. D. Collins, then administrative assistant to Mrs. Fairclough, wrote Paul Martin at that time opposing MP for Essex West, that Minaudo's appeal against deportation had been dismissed March 9, 1961.

The letter said Minaudo was given a six-month suspension of the deportation order.

"The six months was later extended to roughly three years," the MPs said in their statement to Mr. Pearson.

They said the immigration department knew Minaudo's record.

U.S. Satellite Sends Data On Radiation

CAPE KENNEDY, Fla. (AP)—The windmill-shaped explorer 26 scientific satellite whirled into orbit Monday and began radiating a stream of information on natural and man-made radiation.

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration said the satellite could make important contributions to the Apollo manned lunar landing program, specifically in the design of protective materials for the spacecraft and in charting a safe course through the ocean of potentially deadly radiation which surrounds the earth.

The 101-pound electronic package, launched at 4 a.m. atop a three-stage Delta rocket, carries five experiments designed to learn how high energy radiation particles are injected through the atmosphere and eventually lost in the van Allen radiation belt.

NASA said the satellite had achieved a highly elliptical orbit ranging from 150 to 15,200 miles. The nuclear blast, named Starfish, was conducted over the Pacific Ocean in 1962. The Van Allen band extends over the most intense radiation from about 600 to more than 40,000 miles above the earth, also the heaviest concentration of particles remaining from a about 2,000 miles high.
