IN MEMORIAM

JOHN MURRAY
There passed away the Charlotteville Hospital on Sunday, September 30, 1956, a most highly respected citizen in the person of Mr. John Murray. About two years ago the deceased was superannuated from the C.N.R. Railway, and since that time has been a sufferer from a lingering illness. Despite the best medical skill and the constant ministrations of a loving wife and daughter, the solicitude of generous friends and neighbors, Death, the grim reaper, finally triumphed.
Of a naturally sociable and vivacious nature, he accepted the heavy cross and though suffering most of the time, he was never known to complain and received his friends with composure. His passing was a fitting close to an exemplary Christian life and those about him were deeply edified by his heroic patience and perfect resignation to the will of the Divine Redeemer.
The deceased was born at Albany sixty-two years ago and joined the C.N.R. Railway at the station in 1888. He belonged to one of the oldest and most respected families in the province, the oldest son of the late Aeneas Murray and Margaret Campbell. He was possessed of a strong and powerful constitution and a man of irreproachable character and sterling integrity. By thrift, intelligence and honorable dealing he was soon promoted to section foreman which position he held at Borden and later at Summerside for the past twenty years.
By his death Summerside Parish has lost a charitable neighbor, the Catholic Church a pious and faithful member and his family an ideal husband and a kind indulgent father. Great as the loss of his passing is to society, infinitely greater it is to his widow, formerly Eliza Noonan of Albany, his only daughter (Myrtle) Mrs. Jack Keenan, Edmundston, N.B. Also three grand children, Sue, Jane and Kathy Keenan. Poignantly indeed must they feel the loss of so true and loving a husband and father. But confidence in an all-wise God cannot fail to sustain them in their hour of affliction, for though the gloom of sorrow may first seem impervious to mortal eyes, hope still sees a star and faith and love is able to penetrate the darkest cloud. He also leaves to mourn one brother, Adrian at Albany, and three sisters, (Mamie) Mrs. Keir Bassett, Albany, (Addie) Mrs. Frank Murphy, Augustine Cove and (Katie) Mrs. Trainor of Charlotteville. One sister, Mrs. Margaret Garland, predeceased him six years ago.
The funeral was held on Wednesday, September 12th from the Bowness Funeral Home to St. Paul's Church, Summerside, where Requiem High Mass was celebrated by Rev. Father Joseph MacLeod. Seated in the sanctuary were Monsignor MacLellan, Father Harold Croken, Kinkora, Father Reginald MacDonald, Seven Mile Bay, Father Emanuel Richard officiated at the grave. There with the solemn committal rites his mortal remains were laid away to commingle with his parent dust and to await a glorious resurrection. There was a large attendance of citizens to pay a last tribute of respect to one who had so worthily filled his place in the community for so many years.
The pallbearers, six nephews chosen by the deceased were: George Murray, Aeneas Murray, Aeneas Bassett, Ellsworth Bassett, Lloyd Murphy and Thomas Trainor.
