VETERANS' TRAINING DEADLINE — Warning to all wartime merchant navy veterans that Sept. 30 is the deadline for applications for the vocational training benefits obtained for them by the Canadian Merchant Navy Veterans' Association was issued yesterday by A. J. Heide, national secretary. All wartime seamen who have not yet applied for this training are urged to immediately write to the Department of Veterans' Affairs at Ottawa, or contact their nearest DVA office. The training includes practically every vocation desired and carries with it living allowances. "In view of the fact that the government has not given sufficient publicity to the deadline for vocational training applications, we ask that readers pass this information along to all known wartime seamen," Mr. Heide said.
