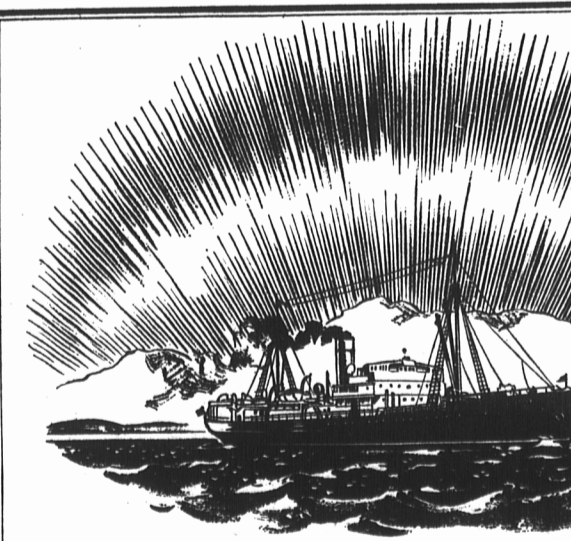
Prepare For Winter Games
