Therapy Specialists

Miss Chalk comes to the Staff of the Sanatorium on high recommendations from medical men who specialize in polio.

Associated with Miss Chalk in specialist work at the Sanatorium and throughout the Province is Miss Heather MacLean, a graduate from McGill University in physical and occupational therapy, who joined the staff during the summer.

Mrs. William Wignmore, R. N., has been rendering valuable work in assisting at physiotherapist work since 1951.

At present sixteen polio patients are under treatment at the Sanatorium and five others come in daily for treatment.

Friday is out-patients' day, when patients of longer standing and those of more mature age check in at the Sanatorium for routine exercises and a check-up. Eight patients are visited weekly in the area between Mt. Stewart and Souris and seven patients at Murray Harbour are also visited. One patient at O'Leary and one at Cape Traverse receive similar attention.

On these visits the patients are given exercises and their parents are instructed how to continue the treatments. Posture is watched and carefully checked against previous visits in order to note progress and give new instructions as improvement is indicated.
