- 1) Responsible for planning, design and setting up of 1974-75 yearbook. Co-ordinates committee and budget for yearbook.

MOVIE CLUB CHAIRMAN

- 1) Rents movies for Sunday night. Co-ordinates movie club productions.

STUDENT DIRECTORY CHAIRMAN

- 1) Collects information and prepares it for publication of a student directory. Engages publisher.

BAR MANAGER

- 1) Is responsible for co-ordinating and providing bar services to union liquor activities.

STUDENT JUDICIAL COMMITTEE

- 1) Chairman must be exclusive of the council and a Junior or Senior. He is appointed by the council. (Information on powers of SJC and disciplinary procedures are available at the SU office).

ELECTORAL BOARD

- 1) Chairman - Is responsible to direct all elections and by-elections for the UPEISU in accordance with the SU Constitution.

SPEAKER

- 1) The Speaker shall preside at all meetings of council, executive and general membership meetings. Is responsible for interpretation of the constitution and Robert's Rules of Order which will be the guidelines for all meetings.

RECORDING SECRETARY

- 1) Keeps an orderly account of the minutes of all council and executive meetings and general meetings and performs other secretarial duties in co-operation with the speaker.

ORIENTATION

- 1) Chairman represents S.U. in orientation planning and in union activities throughout the week of orientation.

OCTOBERFEST

- 1) Chairman, co-ordinates & plans Octoberfest.

WINTER CARNIVAL

- 1) Chairman, plans and carries out Winter Carnival Week.

SOCIAL COMMITTEE

- 1) Chairman - co-ordinates all on-campus social activities.
