Ottawa Bakery Goes After Frozen Pies Export Market

OTTAWA (CP) - Sending pastry to England is almost a par with shipping costs, but Ottawa's Morrison-Lamothe Bakery is doing it - 2,000,000 frozen fruit pies.

Established as a major Australian food store chain, Morrison-Lamothe obtained the 2,000,000-pie order from England that will keep it busy on round-the-clock shifts for several months.

LABOR BOARD SUGGESTS TALKS BY RAIL UNIONS

OTTAWA (CP) - The Canada Labor Relations Board has directed two railway unions and the CNR to get together to thrash out any jurisdictional conflicts among non-operating employees of the publicly-owned railways.
