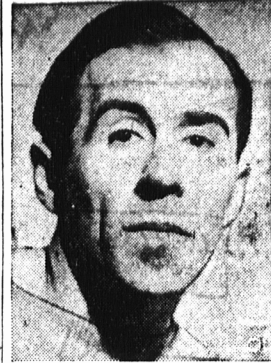

Love for acting came early to Gratien Gellinas. As a boy writer-actor-impressionist he put on many shows at home in Montreal. Later, in his well-known characterization of "Fridolin"—a street urchin—he used the same backyard setting for many of his revues. By 1949 his play "Ti-Coq" was a big success in Montreal and Toronto. It was taken to Broadway but did not survive. The University of Montreal gave him an honorary degree. The Societe des Auteurs Dramatiques presented him with a special plaque. He had won a unique place in the hearts of the French-Canadian radio and theatre public. He was born in Tite Champlain in the St. Maurice River Valley of Quebec, Dec. 8, 1906.
