

British MP Levels Blast At Beaverbrook

VANCOUVER (CP)—E. H. C. Leather, a member of the British House of Commons, in an interview Monday called Lord Beaverbrook's newspapers "the most jingoistic, scurrilous and irresponsible in the world."

Mr. Leather, a Canadian, is the Conservative member for Somerset in the Commons. He was born in Toronto in 1919.

He claimed the papers published by fellow-Canadian Lord Beaverbrook are "the yellowest in the world," a title, he said, once held by the Hearst group in the United States.

He said Beaverbrook's Daily Express does immense and untold harm to Anglo-American relations.

"True it publishes news from America but it is on such matters as divorce, scandal, murder and anything. Any serious news from the U.S. gets tucked away in a corner."

Mr. Leather added he "regrets" Lord Beaverbrook is a Canadian.
