PRESTON JAMES KENNEDY A host of friends and acquaintances were shocked and saddened to learn of the sudden passing in the Prince Edward Island Hospital, on June 28th, of Preston James Kennedy, President of the firm of P. J. and C. Kennedy, General Merchants, Ltd., Kensington.

Born on February 12, 1886, he was the son of the late James Kennedy, M.L.A., and Mrs. Kennedy, Kensington.

Endowed with good judgement, a pleasing and friendly personality, yet of a quiet and unassuming manner, Mr. Kennedy was an outstanding citizen of the town of Kensington, one to whom many came for advice and help. He gave many years of devoted service to his community and province. He served as Councillor on the Town Council for several terms; as trustee of both the P.E.I. Protestant Orphanage and the Prince County Hospital; and was ever ready to assist in many other avenues of public effort. He was prominent in Masonic activities. He was a past master of the Mount Zion Lodge in Kensington, past high priest of Prince Edward Chapter, Royal Arch Masons; at the time of his death he was three-pulsant Grand Master Albert Edward Lodge of Perfection, Summerside; member of Keith Chapter, Rose Croix, Halifax; member of Nova Scotia Consistory, Halifax, where he attained his 32nd degree; member of Thistle Temple, A.A.O.I.M.S., and a member of Shrine Club in Charlottetown. He was also a recreative in this province of the Grand Lodge of Ireland.

Surviving are his wife, the former Daisy Orr; one son, Keith with the firm; four grand children; two brothers, Charles and Dr. Roy and one sister, Marion, Mrs. Ray Stewart, of Hamilton, Ontario. A brother Earl, and sister Rachel predeceased him.

The funeral service, which was very largely attended, was held from his late residence in Charlottetown, was conducted by the Rev. E. H. Bean of the Kensington Presbyterian Church, assisted by the Rev. L. M. Murray of the United Church. Hymns sung were "The Lord is My Shepherd" and "The King of Love My Shepherd Is". The many beautiful flowers expressed the loving memory and sympathy of relatives and friends. Pall bearers were Roscoe Walker, William Thompson, Walter Wilson, Earl Braham, Robert Palmer and Frank Daley. Funeral direction was under J. L. Davidson and burial was in the Kensington cemetery.
