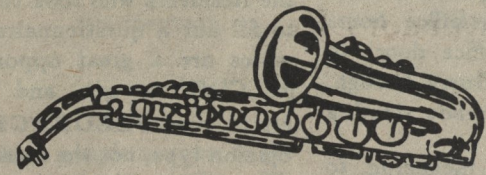


Music Society Pub


