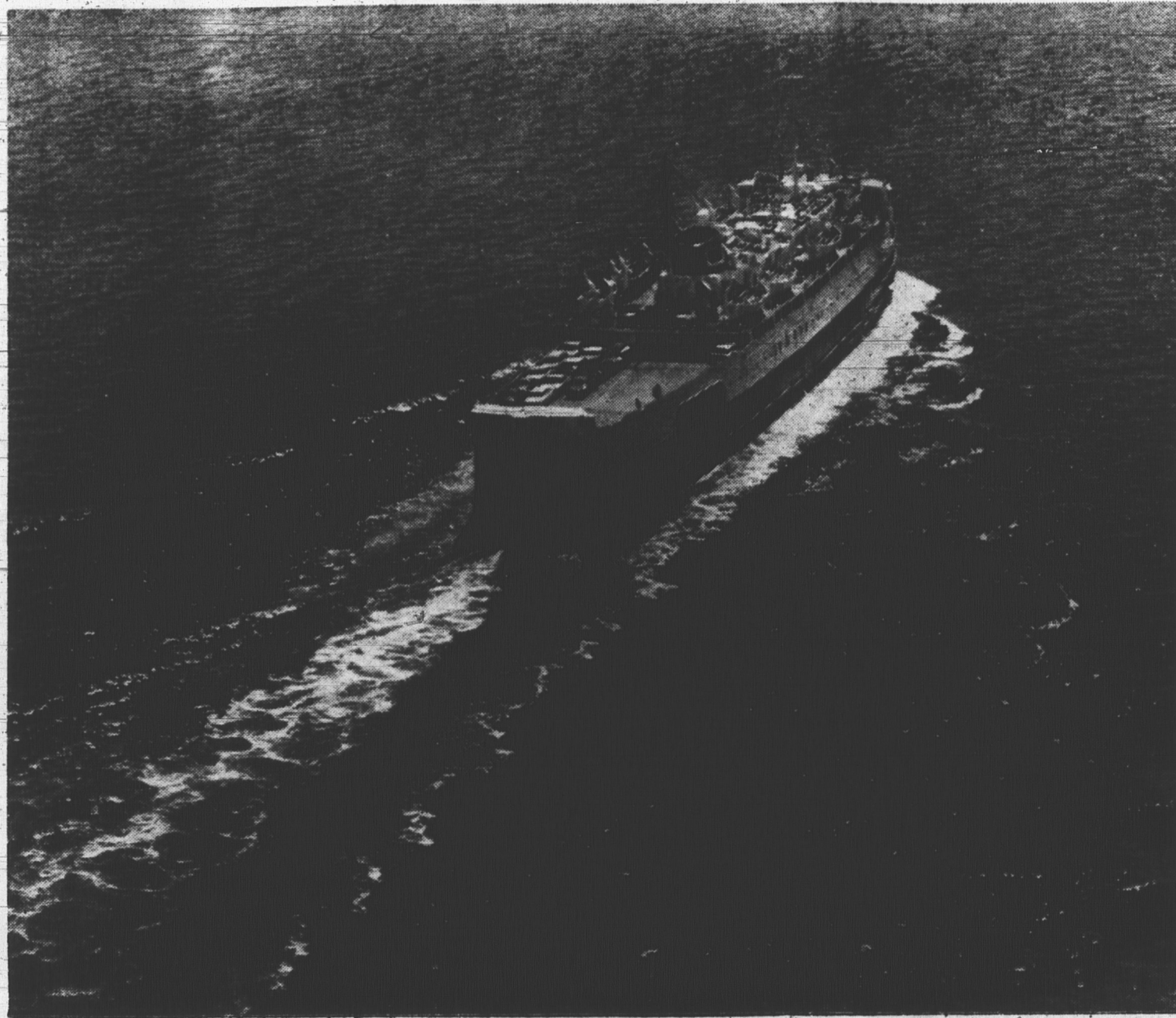
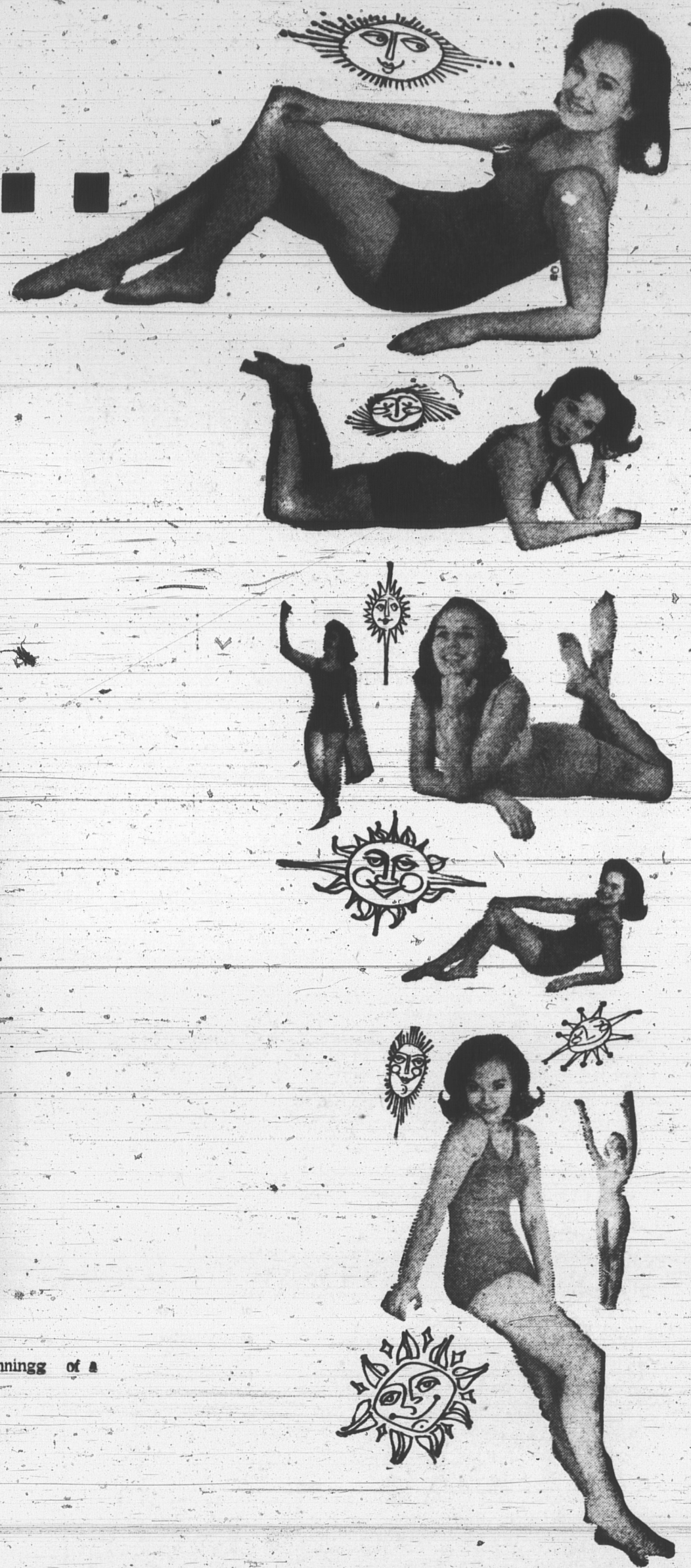

To Prince Edward Island!



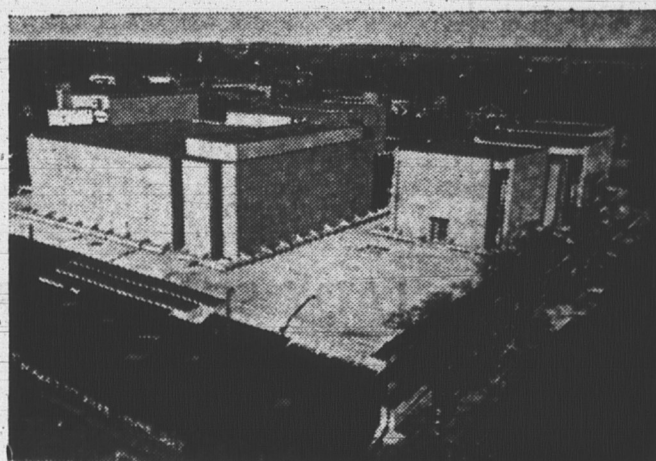
Pictured above is the M. V. Abegweit making one of its many voyages from New Brunswick to Prince Edward Island, the beginning of a beautiful vacation.
