ACRES OF SPACE FOR CAMPER S

Variety available in camp sites

Fifty provincial parks and campgrounds are geared to the needs of the 100,000 or more campers who yearly spend a pleasant summer holiday at the beachside in Prince Edward Island.

Camping has become a way of life with the hundreds of thousands of visitors who journey Canada's East coast. Ten years ago the first campgrounds were built in Prince Edward Island. The first was at Stratgartney, about 15 miles west of Charlottetown on the Trans Canada Highway. The National Park has pioneered with campsites at Cavendish, Brackley and Stanhope. In recent years private campgrounds have entered the field.

In the past six years most of the existing campground network, extending right across the province, has mushroomed. For 1965 there are a total of 4 National Park Campgrounds, 20 Provincial Parks and 26 private campgrounds.

These camping sites range from 10 to 240 acres in area and offer a wide variety of services and facilities. Most of them are located near a beach or river. All are close to small communities where recreation, shopping and other needs are fulfilled. Fees for overnight tenting in the National Park are only 50 cents, in Provincial Parks 75 cents and in private campgrounds average \$1.50. Most parks and campgrounds on the island accommodate trailers and many provide full hook-ups.

If the traveller wants to pick a park with a picturesque name in Prince Edward Island he has such places as Stratgartney Park, Brudenell, Green Park, Cedar Dunes or Cabot to choose from.

The island also has some of the most appealing picnic sites to be found anywhere. Some of these are along the roadside, others are tucked away under shade trees at the side of a quiet brook.

More and more tourists each year are discovering the delights of an outdoor vacation on Prince Edward Island and new campsites are being built to meet the demand.

Northumberland Park—Frank MacMillan, Situated 2 miles east of Wood Island Ferry terminal on Highway No. 4 in a scenic cove overlooking one of the island's finest beaches, excellent for swimming, sun bathing. Safe for children. Bathing house for children playgrounds, clam digging, picnic tables, fire places, kitchen shelters, range in recreation hall for cook-outs. Washrooms with flush toilets, hot showers and automatic laundry. Movies and organized activities in recreation hall. Bonfires and deepsea fishing arranged. Groceries and supplies, block ice etc., at canteen on premises. 60 tent sites under trees, 60 tent sites in grassed area overlooking beach. Tap water and electric hook-ups. All sites equipped with picnic table and covered garbage container. Tents—\$1.50 per night, \$9.00 per week, \$30.00 per month. Trailers, with hook-ups, \$2.00 per night, \$12.00 per week, \$40.00 per month. Enjoy natural surroundings at Northumberland Park. It's rough and ready with modern conveniences.

RUSTICO ACRES TENTING AREA—J. W. Francis. Space for 30 tents in beautiful setting. Modern restrooms with showers, picnic tables for each tent. Situated on lower Cavendish Road, 5 minutes from Green Gables golf course, 3 minutes from sandy supervised beach, shopping centre, deep sea fishing, trout fishing on property. Rates \$1.00 per night. HARBOR VUE CAMP-GROUND AND TRAILER PARK—Irene and Leo Gallant, Prop. Rusticoville, Route 6, 16 trailer hook-ups, 150 tent sites, 10 acres overlooking Rustico Bay, 5 miles from Cavendish Golf Course and Anne of Green Gables, 1/2 mile from North Rustico Shopping Centre and ice. Deep sea fishing arranged at campsite. Private picnic tables, hot showers, fireplaces, laundry, canteen, groceries, and firewood at camp store. Playground, recreation building 20' x 40'. Free movies, T.V., record player, horseshoe game, horseback riding, swimming. No mosquitoes. Rates: Tents \$1.00 per night. Trailers, \$2.00 per day. Phone Rusticoville 31.

LINKLETTER—4 miles west of Summerside. 15 acres 20 tents, 10 trailers, picnic tables, fireplaces, kitchen shelter, bathing house with flush toilets, tap water, temporary camping for early and late ferry crossings, charcoal available. Playground with horseshoes.

ST. PETERS—Routes 2, 30 sites from Charlottetown, 12 acres, 20 tents, 10 trailers, picnic tables, fireplaces, kitchen shelter, playground, outdoor toilets, bathing house with flush toilets, tap water, showers, camping, picnicking, swimming. Charcoal available. Paved road in park.

BLOOMFIELD—On Route 2 between O'Leary and Alberton, 12 acres, 20 tents, 10 trailers, picnic tables, fireplaces, outdoor toilets, kitchen shelter, comfort station with flush toilets, playground with horseshoes, camping, fishing, picnicking, charcoal available.

ALBANY—3 miles from Borden on Route 1, Trans-Canada Highway 1 acre 6 tents 2 trailers, picnic tables, fireplaces, swings, flush toilets, tap water. Temporary camping for early and late ferry crossings. Official tourist information.

BONSHAW—Route 1 leading to Borden, 16 miles from Charlottetown. 6 acres, 12 tents, 6 trailers, picnic tables, fireplaces, outdoor toilets, pump water playground, fishing, swimming, all sizes have fireplaces, firewood, toilet facilities and picnic tables.

CAVENDISH CAMPGROUND—225 tent lots, 11 kitchen shelters, 2 toilet and laundry buildings, 7 toilet and shower buildings, central laundry building, playground. Lifeguard at beach. Amphitheatre. Rates: 50c per night, \$2.00 per week.

RUSTICO ISLAND CAMPGROUND—150 tent sites. Lifeguard at beach. Service at this campground will not be as elaborate as Cavendish and Stanhope for 1965.

"PRIMITIVE" CAMP SITE—STANHOPE AREA—7 tents, outdoor toilets, spring water, fireplace. Inquire at Stanhope Campground or from the District Park Warden about exact location and to register.

NATIONAL PARK TRAILER AREAS—Trailer Parks in the National Park supply electricity, sewer, water connections, also laundry and shower facilities.

CAVENDISH CAMPGROUND—77 hook-ups with sewer, electricity, and water. Rates \$1.50 per day.

STANHOPE BEACH—14 hook-ups with sewer, electricity, and water. Rates \$1.50 per day.

NATIONAL PARK PICNIC GROUNDS—Picnic grounds are located throughout the National Park area. The majority of these sites have kitchen shelters, playground equipment, supervised swimming, and dressing cubicles. All sizes have fireplaces, firewood, toilet facilities and picnic tables.

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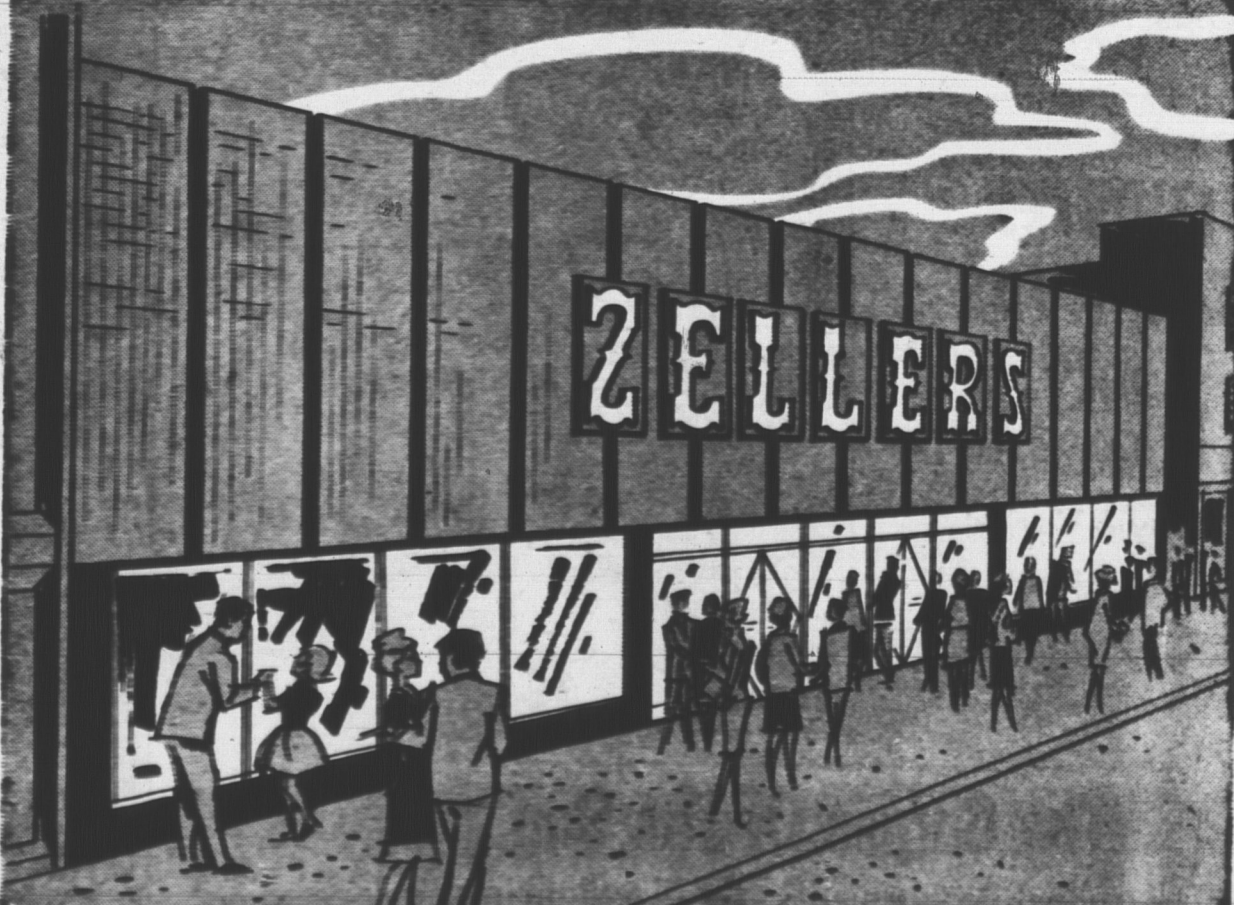
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
