 Sweetheart, Sweetheart!

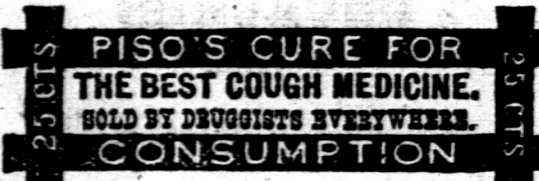

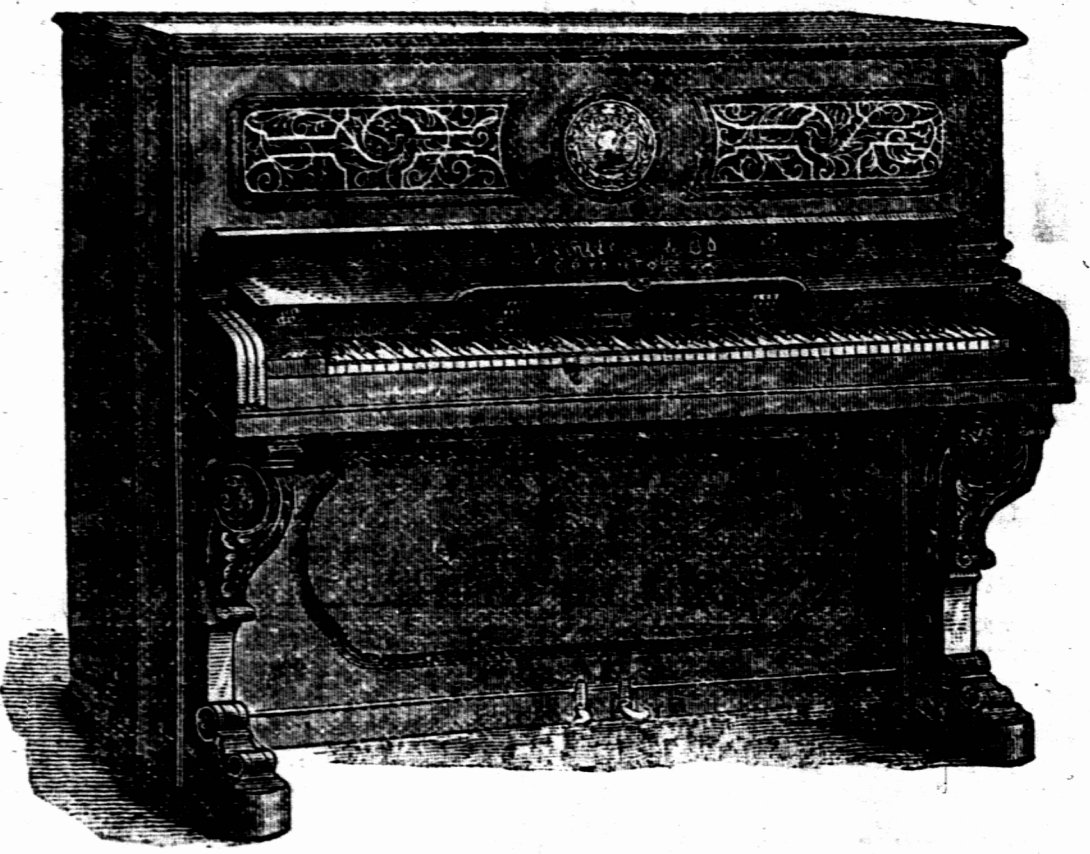

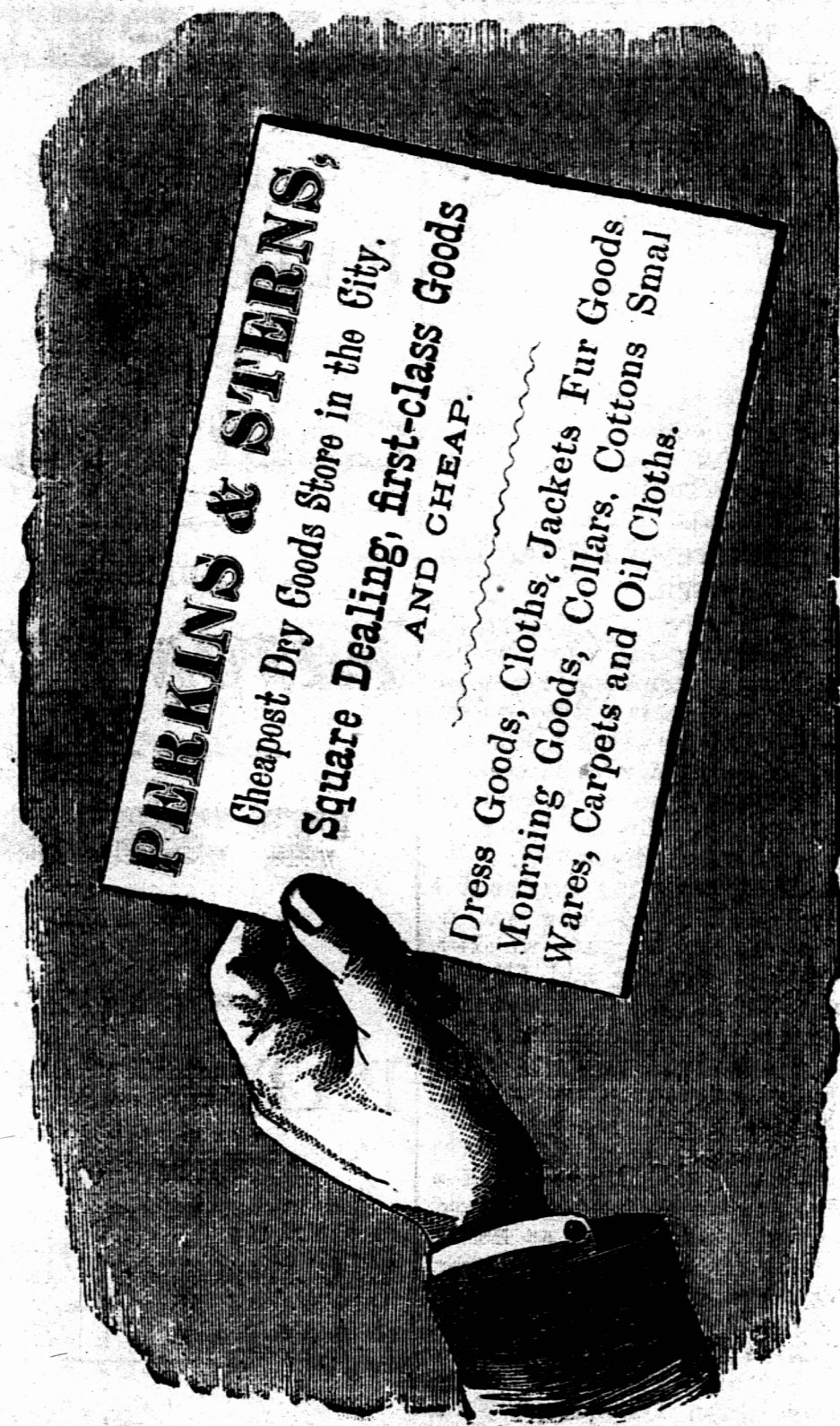
