The hesitation of investors was reflected by the lightest trading in three months. Volume was 4,360,000 shares compared with 6,080,000 Friday and was the smallest since June 6 when 4,270,000 shares changed hands.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) - Investors extended their long weekend Tuesday on the Toronto Stock Exchange when the trading tempo slowed to its lightest since June 20.

Volume was 2,043,000 shares down from 2,132,000 Friday as industrial resumes their prolonged downward drift after a brief rally last week.

Banks paced the main list lower with Nova Scotia off 1 1/2 to 64, Royal 3/4 to 67 1/2, Toronto-Dominion 1/4 to 54, Montreal 1/4 to 54 1/2 and Imperial-Commerce 1/2 to 57 1/2.

Over-all the industrial index, an indicator of how key stocks move, fell 5 1/2 to 146.15.

Quebec Mattagami tumbled 18 to 91 cents in speculative mines while Provo Gas gained 10 cents to 4.00 on 139,749 shares in oils.

Declines outnumbered advances 215 to 169 with 224 issues unchanged.

On index, base metals were up 46 to 87.75, western oils 70 to 98.03 while the TSE eased 39 to 139.50.
