# Mammoth parade spectacle is scheduled Friday morning

While everyday is a big day during the annual Old Home Week celebration something extra special is scheduled for Friday, Aug. 16. This is the day of the giant Gold Cup and Saucer Parade, a spectacular that drew 22,000 people to see it when held for the first time last year. This year's parade promises to be every bit as big and every bit as good as last year and will be topped off by the appearance of a nationally known television and radio star Joyce Sullivan of Toronto.

Miss Sullivan will ride in the parade in an open convertible. She will also appear later in the day prior to the running of the first dash of The Evening Patriot Gold Cup and Saucer Race at the Driving Park and still later she will be heard in a 10-15 minute concert at the park. ... TO SEE SPECTACLE ... Last year's parade and anything ever seen in Charlottetown according to many spectators and parade officials is confident that the public will again see an eye opening spectacle. There are several new features as well as the attractions that proved so popular last year. More beauty has been added to this year's parade with the addition of 14 high stepping majorettes from Yarmouth, N.S. The majorettes are appearing courtesy of the City of Charlottetown. In addition a large number of clowns will perform their laugh provoking antics all along the parade route. There will be at least 20 floats of every type and description in the parade as well as seven bands, marching units from visiting Royal Canadian Navy warships and an American Submarine Sea Owl, horses and ponies with riders, go-kart racing cars, and an assortment of other things as well as, of course, The Evening Patriot's Gold Cup and Saucer girls riding in open convertibles. The seven bands that will be appearing will include two off the island bands the Balmoral Girls Pipers from St. John's, N.S. and the Fredericton Air Cadet Band from Fredericton, N.S. The other bands are all from P.E.I. They include the Band of the Prince Edward Island Regiment, judged last year to be the best in the parade; high school bands from Birchwood and Queen Charlotte; the Lovat Scots Pipe Band and the Summerside RCAF band.

The parade at 10 o'clock in the morning will touch off a full day of activity. Following the parade at noon a luncheon sponsored by the city and the Provincial Exhibition Association will be held at the Charlottetown Hotel. Guests will include 111 military personnel from the visiting ships, the Gold Cup and Saucer girls and Miss Sullivan. At 2 p.m. in downtown Charlottetown a band concert will be given by the Balmoral Pipes and another band as yet unnamed. Precision drills will also be seen during the band concert. Then in the evening it's off to the Driving Park for the running of the Gold Cup and Saucer

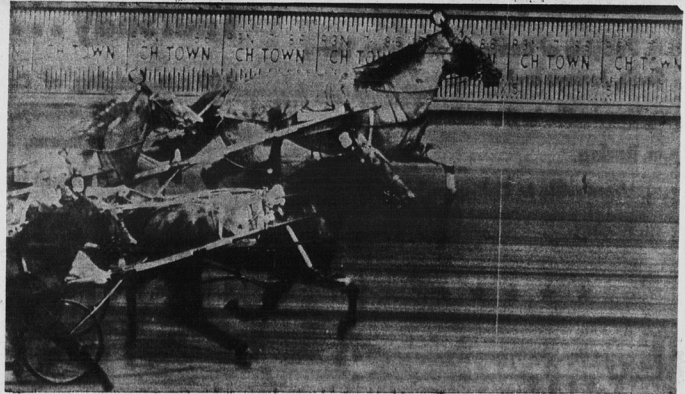
