Says Expulsion May Not Have Been Spontaneous

NORTH BAY, Ont. (CP) A woman Liberal member of the Commons said during the week-end that the expulsion of Progressive Conservative Donald Fleming from a House committee meeting last week may not have been spontaneous.

Mrs. Ann Shipley, the member for Timiskaming, spoke to a regional conference of the Canadian Federation of University Women.

Mr. Fleming, who sits for Eglinton riding, was expelled when he crossed swords with the deputy chairman of the meeting which was considering the government's hotly-disputed legislation enabling an \$80,000,000 loan for a trans-Canada pipeline.

Mrs. Shipley said she wouldn't go so far as to say the expulsion was "a prepared plan" but she wondered how 20 reporters managed to congregate outside the committee room by the time Mr. Fleming emerged.

Shortly after Mr. Fleming left the room, Mrs. Ellen Fairclough, Progressive Conservative member for Hamilton West, arose and draped a Union Jack over his desk.

Asked Mrs. Shipley: "Is it feasible to think that we go around carrying eight-foot flags in our hip pockets?"

Contract Let For Steel Piping

LONDON (CP) — A \$32,000,000 contract for steel piping for the Trans-Canada Pipe Line Company has been awarded to a British firm, it was announced today.

The contract was signed in New York last Thursday with South Durham Steel and Iron Company Ltd., a British firm which has an antipipeline order from the West-coast Transmission Company.

Delivery of the first piping will be in May, 1957, and the contract is expected to be completed by July, 1959.

Asked about the controversy raging in Canada over the pipeline company's financing, a company official said:

"The contract is with the pipe line company, not the government."

Altogether 636 miles of 30-inch diameter piping will be used for the centre section of the natural gas line from Winnipeg to North Bay, Ont.

Strike Shuts Down Price Bros. Mills

JONQUERE, Que. (CP) — A newspaper strike affecting 2,000 men employed by Price Bros. and Co. Ltd. went into its sixth day Monday with no sign of settlement.

Three mills at Jonquiere, Kenogami and Riverbend—which produce about 470,000 tons of newsprint annually—are idle because of the wage war called by the National Syndicate of Pulp and Paper Workers (N.S.P.W.).

Secretary Jean Marchand of the Canadian and Catholic Confederation of Labor said there is "no sign at all" of settlement despite the efforts of a provincial conciliator.

No meetings were scheduled for Monday and Mrs. Marchand said the last discussions were held Friday.

The strike has been orderly and conditions are described as "very peaceful" in the Lake St. John district towns.

Famed Legion To Be Stripped Of Its Glamor
 By RONALD BATCHELOR AMMAN, Jordan (Reuters)—The famed Arab Legion, Jordan's British-trained army, will be stripped of its glamor—and even of its title—under a new program revealed Saturday.

Defence Minister Mohammed Al Ajlouni disclosed plans to abolish the legion's colorful uniforms and to merge the desert fighters with the Jordan national guard in an expanded modern force under the plain title "Jordan Army."

Members of the 35-year-old legion will be clothed in western-style khaki—if the project is approved by King Hussein.
